- ✓ Conclude by sharing observations about how volunteers befitted while creating materials that will deliver significant results in the short term and long term during multiple ongoing programs over the next 2-3 years.

Community programs supported include children's yoga, art therapy to foster inclusion and diversity, learning activities to support children who learn differently, annual celebrations for Halloween, the ladybug release, and cultural events that foster solidarity, safety, and oneness.
