Storylines

Keith Livingston (A Story)

An innocent man wakes to find himself locked down in a violent South Texas Jail. Dangerous plots and desperate people surround him. His hidden background and moral character will be revealed to show how far he will go to get out of **DownSTexas**.

Sheriff Vince Nilesh and His Posse (C Story)

Sheriff Nilesh runs the County with an iron White fist. His overriding goal is to maintain the County's old German control at any cost. He works with the most dangerous cartels and profits from his network of human trafficking/drug trade. After all, "It's for the greater good". He has carefully groomed his minions: Officer Ferrel (his nephew), Detective Dietche, the Nurse, the County Prosecutor and DA, plus most of the County Deputies.

Sergeant Strand (C Story)

The moral compass and the key to exposing all of the hidden schemes in this dirty County.

Lieutenant Wayne (C Story)

Not an immoral man, but rather an amoral man. Upholds the law while always looking out for No. 1. His allies are Sergeant Strand, Officer Amanda, Officer Dinkler, and Shorty with his Orejones. He has big plans, but how will they end - and is Keith the key?

Francisco "Pancho" (B Story)

Huge backstory - Army (Full Disability). Has full-on PTSD. He doesn't speak about his Mid-East deployments, his E4 - 18 Series sniper rank, or his number of kills per day. Can he leave his past behind and truly "be all that he can be"?

Characters

Keith Livingston

Keith Livingston. Early 40's, easily recognizable as the "The Cleancut - Good Guy". But looks can be deceiving, and this South Texas hell hole will reveal Keith's true inner core.

Officer Ferrel

Cruel and unbalanced mid 30's 5' 6" Caucasian male CO. Sheriff Nilesh is his uncle. Enjoys humiliating and mind-fucking inmates, with a never-ending smile. Celebrates 4/20 (Hitler's Birthday) - Literally. He lives over his mother's garage. Openly despises homosexual and transgender identities, but forces inmates to masturbate for him. Has a huge cache of BDSM sex toys in his placarded closet, "The Dungeon", at his mother's home.

Detective Dietche

Mid 50's large, square Caucasian female County Detective and the Head of APS (Adult Protective Services). Manner of speech sounds like a Platoon Captain barking orders. Stoically cruel and driven. Sweats corruption.

Deputy Verdado

Hispanic male County Deputy in his 20's. He carries a valuable "missing shard" that ultimately threatens the County status quo.

Sergeant/Officer Strand

Mid 50' male CO with a soft Texas drawl. Kind and insightful. Takes care of his own mother who has dementia. Your basic solid guy next door.

Shorty

Very short mid 40's Hispanic Trustee inmate. A humorous manner of speaking with Mexican slang thrown about covers a Machiavellian mind. His left eye seriously misaligned to stare to the far left. "This way I can keep track of everything that's going on." And he does. Shorty knows what is going down before anyone does; Including Lieutenant Wayne. San Antonio Tango Orejon leader. Moral within reason. Says he just wants to get home to his family. The question - Who is his real family?

Smurf

Short bearded mid 40's Caucasian inmate who strongly resembles Papa Smurf, with even shorter legs. Jovial but not all there. He may have a sharp edge; or two.

Josh

Joshua Livingston. Keith's 65 year-old father. Unfortunately disabled due to a debilitating stroke. Caucasian. Still has a driven demeanor.

Minxie

Minou Livingston. Keith's 65 year-old mother. Caucasian/Native American suffering Severe Decline dementia. Bright, kind, but very lost, green eyes.

Luis

(Has named himself '8 Ball'). Mid 20's, very tall and muscular Hispanic inmate. Obvious mental challenges. Has cartel child-like fantasies. Oddly savant at Beatbox and rap which sometimes carries over to his normal speaking voice.

Lieutenant Wayne

Mid 60's extra large Caucasian man in charge of the County jail. The definition of Texas Law Enforcement with the accompanying drawl. Cigar always close at hand; equally large.

Nurse

Mid 50's redhead Caucasian LVN who holds herself out as a Registered Nurse. She insists on being addressed as "Nurse Ma'am". Behind her back she is referred to as "La Bruja Roja" - "The Red Witch ". The tightest Lemon Lips with one shoved up her ass for good measure. A seriously cunning and vindictive bitch who has plucked most of her eyebrows out to spite her face. Thoroughly enjoys her power over people's lives in the County jail. Cruel at work and worse at home. She fancies herself as a surgeon and spends her spare time "experimenting" on her many cats and kittens - Dante's Feline Inferno.

Mara

Keith's 43 year-old wife. Very small/petite attractive woman. Comes from wealth and has never worked a day in her life. Unfortunately, mentally ill with an opioid prescription addiction to boot. A hot mess, getting messier.

Officer Grover

Mid 40's male CO. Excessively tall and gangly with bizarre Googly-eyes. His odd head movements only worsen the view.

Officer Amanda

Mid 30's very attractive Hispanic female CO. A bond at first-sight relationship springs to life between Keith and Amanda. Season 2 will reveal even more.

Officer Madria

Mid 40's overweight Hispanic male CO. Dull as dirt and has difficulty even going through the motions. The definition of "I don't give a shit".

Dr. Rodriguez

Small, mid 60's, and very kind Hispanic male General Practitioner. Contracts with the County Jail for medical services and looks the worse for it.

Sheriff Vince Nilesh

The County Sheriff. He has spent many years setting up his pawns in every nook and cranny of the County government. Ruthless and dangerous.

Burner

A mid 30's Caucasian male inmate with some mental deficiencies. Well built and insanely fast and agile. He has a minor cleft lip which becomes more pronounced when he is excited or angry.

El Pandillerro

A 50ish Hispanic male inmate. The real deal with black eyes and an "X" shaped scar on his left cheek. Quiet and deadly. In for murder for the non-delivery of a very specific product.

Officer Schultz

A very large mid 50's Caucasian male CO with an enormous square head. Perpetually disheveled and smells like sour beer and sweat. He hates his wife almost as much as he hates his live-in sister in-law.

Officer Dinkler

A mid 40's small Caucasian male CO. Genuinely friendly in a nervous way. A horndog whose weekly Tinder adventures always end badly. For some reason Keith receives the detailed weekly update.

Attorney - Bud Collins

The former County Prosecutor for over twenty years. Something happened involving Sheriff Niles that ended his career. Now 80 years old, he exists as a third rate Court Appointed Attorney (CAA). He recognizes something different in Keith and sees another County set-up. This is Bud's last shot at taking Sheriff Niles down, and hopefully in the process, freeing an innocent man.

Sterling

A mid 50's Army vet with serious substance issues, largely due to the horrific things he has seen and done.
