

SENDCo

Our SENDCo representative, Emily (sendco@tbr.org.uk), is situated in the Caterpillar Room and oversees the coordination of children within the SEND framework across the setting. Emily tracks the progress of each child and ensure the appropriate support is implemented to meet their individual needs.

Referrals

Speech & Language

A referral may be made to support a child in their speech and language development.

Early Years Support

Referring to Early Years will offer the setting and home support with a child's development offering guidance on ways to expand and enhance the development of each individual child.

Interim Funding

This funding will support a child in having a lower ratio/1-2-1. This will help support the child by having 1 staff member focus and support them in areas of need.

Inclusion funding

This funding provides the setting with funds to provide resources that are specific and focus on a child individual need for example speech or behavioural needs.

Occupational Therapist

Will support each child with a range of needs including sensory (licking objects, covering ears, not touching certain textures and food aversion)

Support Plan

A support plan is a document that is put into place to set goals that will support a child within a range of areas of need in their development, for example if a child was struggling to participate in sharing their step could be to complete a simple sharing activity with an adult. A support plan is reviewed and monitors the progress of the child in their development.

Outside Agencies

Every child is different and has different agencies involved, collaborating and sharing information with the agencies involved with your child provides an approach where everyone is on the same page and will be able to support the child better.

Parent Partnerships

Working with you as parents, your opinions, thoughts, and aspirations is key to each child's development. Permission from parents will always be asked before completing any support for a child and regular updates/meetings are held to keep parents and the SENDCo updated in a child's needs and development.
