Thursday 13th November- World Kindness day. Show an act of kindness at home and upload a photo to parent zone for us to share at nursery.

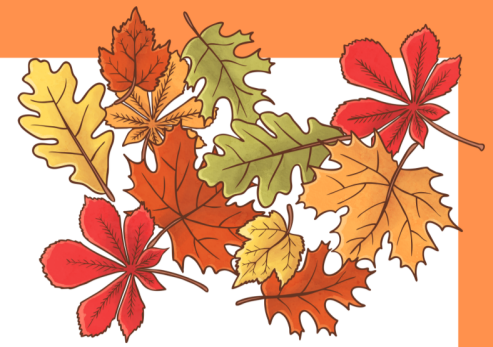
Sunday 30th November- St Andrews Day, Come in dressed in blue and white colours.
