On July 4, 2026, America celebrated 250 years of Independence. “With a single sheet of parchment and 56 signatures, America began the greatest political journey in human history.”

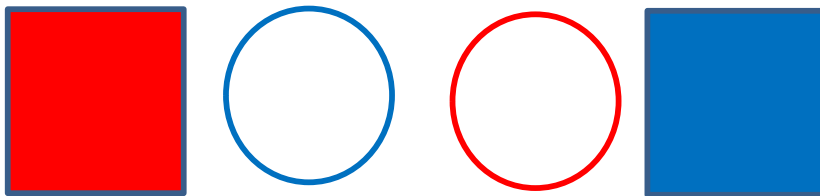
Staging: Pistols holstered, rifle staged the left table. Shotgun staged on either table

Gun Order: Shotgun last **Choice Rifle or Pistols first.**

Starting Position: Standing at the left table with hands touching gun of choice.

Line: “***God Bless America***”

ATB: With pistols and rifle do a 1,7,7,6 sweep from either end. You will need to do a rifle reload to complete the # of shots required for the sweep (**21 shots total**). Rifle may be reloaded at any time. With shot gun knockdown 4 shotgun targets must be past the 250th flag to engage knockdowns.

Remember the Civil War

The American Civil War April 12, 1861 – May 26, 1865. This was a civil war in the United States between the Union^[e] ("the North") and the Confederacy ("the South"), which was formed in 1861 by states that had seceded from the Union. South Carolina had done more than any other state to advance the notion that a state had the right to nullify federal laws and even secede. On December 20, 1860, the convention unanimously voted to secede and adopted a secession declaration.

“Staging: Rifle loaded 10 rounds in the left table.

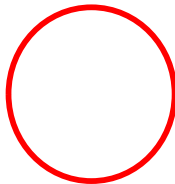
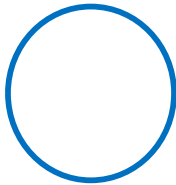
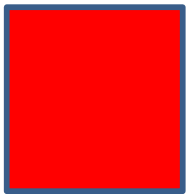
Pistols loaded 5 rounds and holstered.

Shotgun open and empty staged on right table.

Gun order: Rifle not last.

Starting Position: Standing behind the table of choice with your hand over your heart and other hand at your side shooter says **“Long Live Dixie”**

ATB: With rifle and pistols do a 1,8,6,5 sweep from either end. With shotgun knockdown the 4 shotgun targets in any order.

1918**World War 1 The War to End All Wars**

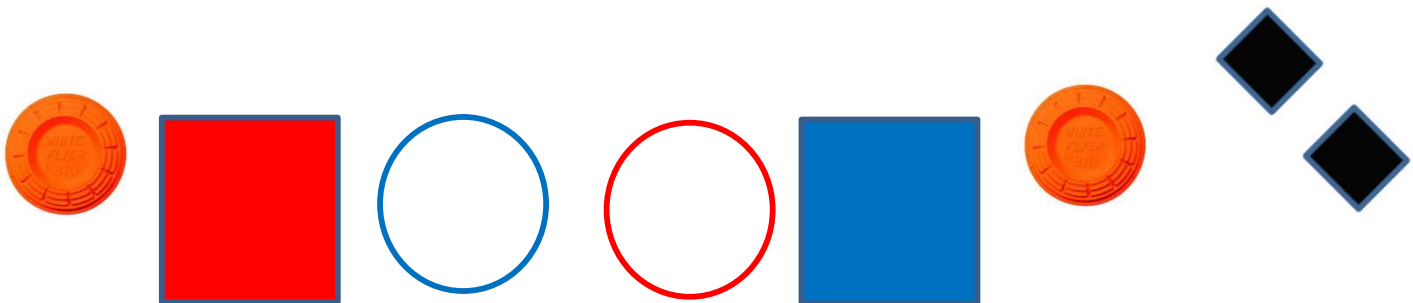
World War I, or the **First World War** (28 July 1914 – 11 November 1918), also known as the **Great War**, was a global conflict between two coalitions: the Allies (or Entente) and the Central Powers. Major theatres of war included Europe and the Middle East, and well as parts of Africa and the Asia-Pacific. One of the deadliest conflicts in history. Known as (“The War to End All Wars”)

Staging: Two pistols loaded with 5 rounds each holstered .
Rifle loaded with 10 rounds on right table
Shotgun, open and empty on the right table.

Gun order: Pistols , Rifle, Shotgun

Starting Position: Standing at the right table both hands touching the American flag shooter says “**The War to End All Wars**”

ATB: With pistols and rifle do a 1,9,1,8 sweep with your last round shoot 1 of the clay targets for a bonus of 5 seconds. Misses on the clay do not count as misses. Knock down the 2 shotgun targets in any order.

WW2 The Global Conflict

1939 to 1945



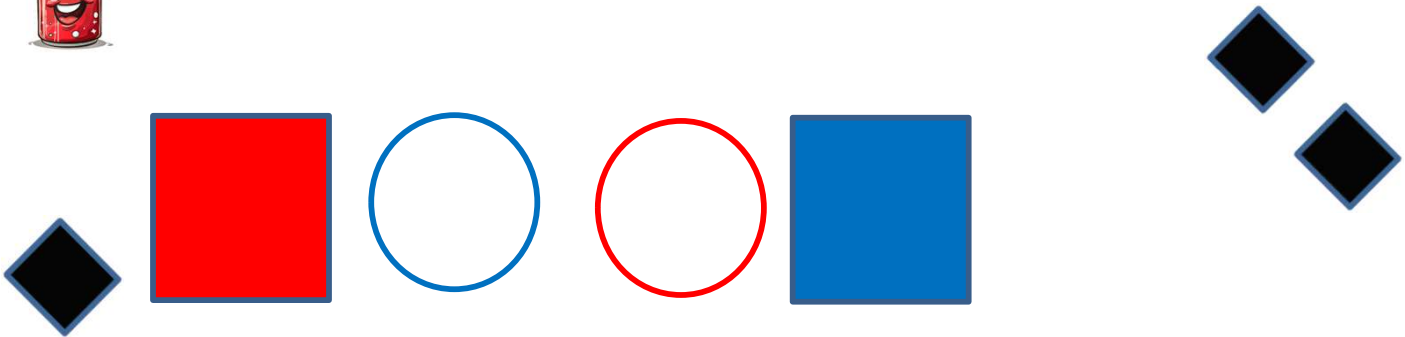
World War II or the **Second World War** began on 1 September 1939, was a global conflict between two coalitions: the Allies and the Axis powers. Nearly all of the world's countries participated. The United States entered the war after the attack on Pearl Harbor **Franklin D. Roosevelt**: “Yesterday, December 7, 1941 — a date which will live in infamy.” Delivered after the attack on Pearl Harbor, this phrase galvanized American resolve to enter the war. The war ended on 9/2/45.

Staging: Two pistols loaded with 5 rounds each holstered .
Rifle loaded with 10 rounds on either table.
Shotgun, open and empty on the either table.

Gun order: Rifle, Shotgun, Pistols

Starting Position: Start standing at the table where the rifle is staged with hands in Texas surrender. Shooter says **“A Date That Will Live In Infamy”**

ATB: With rifle **start** a 9,2,4,5 sweep from either end for 10 rounds make rifle safe and with shot gun from left table shoot the soda can thrower move to the right table and shoot the 2 shotgun knockdowns **or** with shotgun from right table shoot 2 shotgun knockdowns and move to the other table and engage the soda can thrower. Then with your pistols **continue** the 9,2,4,5 sweep.

Stage #5

9/11/2001 Never Forget



The **September 11 attacks** known as **9/11**, - were a coordinated series of suicide attacks perpetrated by the Islamic terrorist organization al-Qaeda against the United States in 2001. Nineteen terrorists hijacked four airliners, then flew one into each of the Twin Towers at the World Trade Center in New York City. The third plane crashed into the Pentagon, the headquarters of the United States Department of Defense, in Arlington County, Virginia. The fourth plane crashed in a rural Pennsylvania field during a passenger revolt.

Staging: Rifle loaded 10 rounds on either table

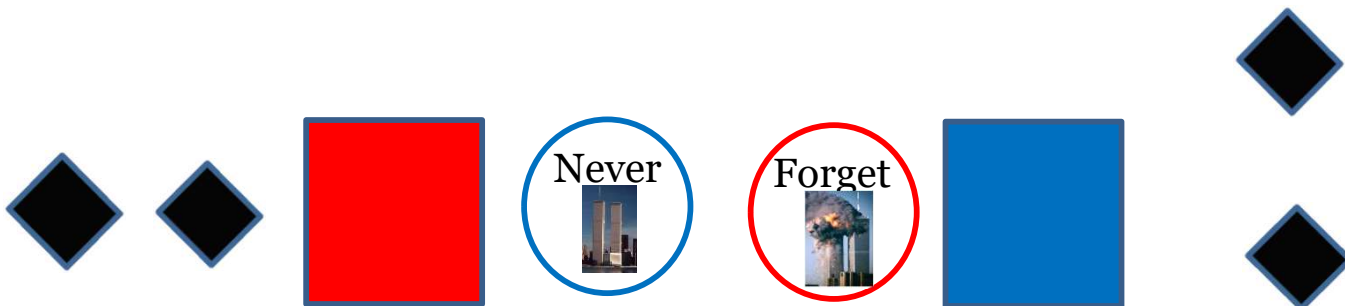
Pistols loaded 5 rounds staged on table with your rifle.

Shotgun open and empty staged on the table with rifle and pistols.

Gun Order: Rifle not last

Starting Position: Standing at the table with your guns both hands touching American Flag shooter says "Never Forget"

ATB: Starting at either end put 9 rounds on the outside target than 11 rounds on the other outside target. With shotgun knockdown shotgun targets in any order you can move if needed.

“Staging: Rifle loaded 10 rounds on either table.

Pistols loaded 5 rounds and holstered shot from either table.

Shotgun open and empty staged on opposite table from your rifle.

Gun Order: Shooter's choice rifle not last

Starting Position: Standing at the table holding the Birthday Cake in both hands' shooter says **“Happy Birthday America”**

ATB: Drop the cake and with pistols and rifle sweep the targets in a 7,4,2,6 sweep from either direction. With shotgun knockdown 2 shotgun targets and move to opposite table and knockdown 2 shotgun targets must be past Uncle Sam.
