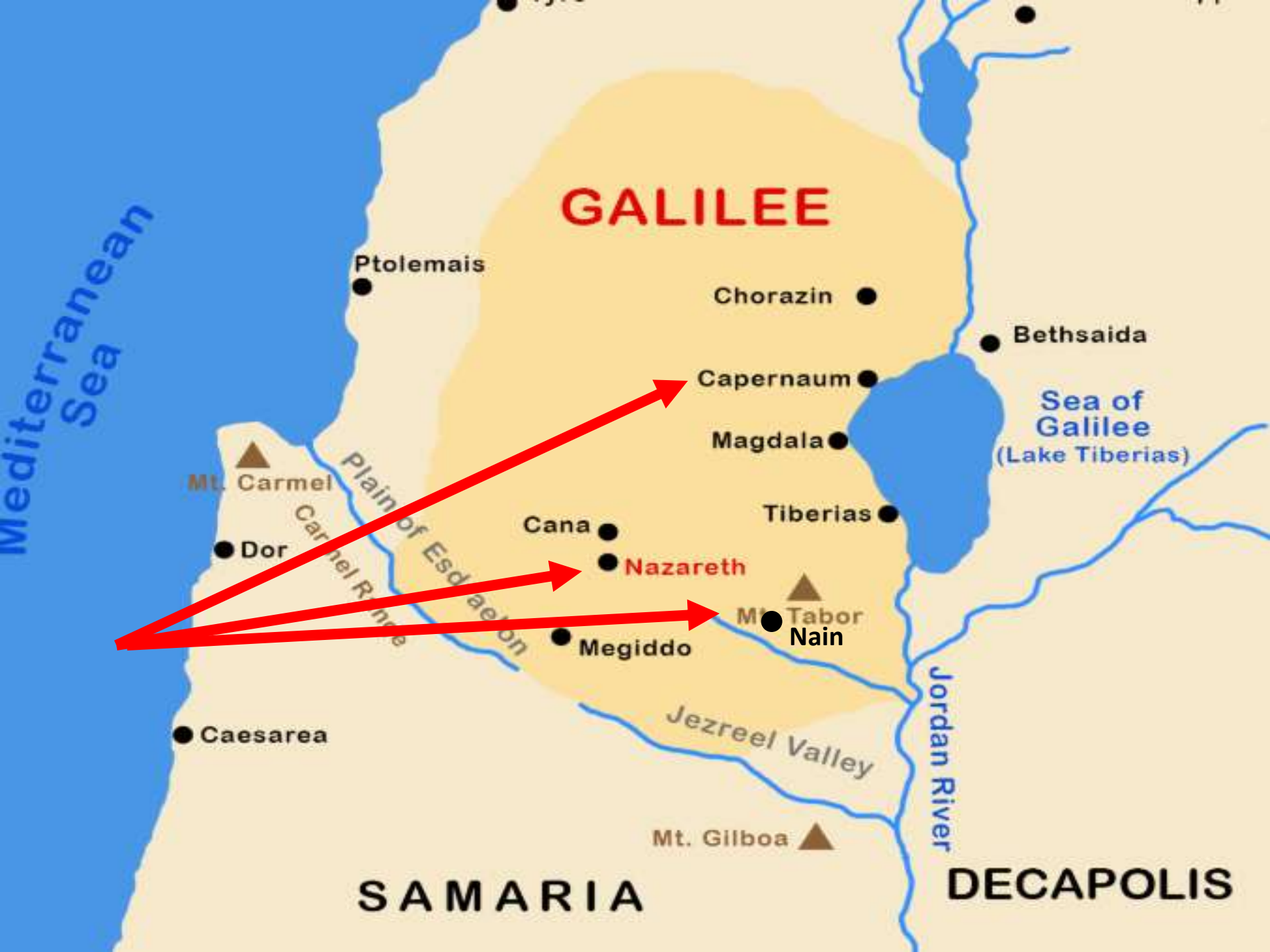

The Gospel only documented three events where Jesus raised someone from the dead.
- (T/F) This event is also captured in the Book of Matthew? **False -**
This story is unique to the Book of Luke
- What is distinguishable about the raising of the widow's son from the other two people Jesus raised?
This was an unsolicited miracle by Jesus of His own initiative.

•What did all three people Jesus raised from the dead have in common?

They all eventually died again.

•What are four key points that can be taken from this even?

- 1) Jesus feels and shows deep compassion over the mother's immense grief**
- 2) Jesus demonstrated He has power over death and restored physical life simply with a touch**
- 3) God has, is and will continue to actively work through Jesus.**
- 4) God always shows up on time.**

- How did Jesus supersede a ritual in this story?

By touching an open coffin, Jesus risked violation of the law (Numbers) becoming legally unclean. However Jesus was more concerned about mercy than the law.

- This event also demonstrates that God does not have to act on the presence or absence of faith ?
