- What is the distinction of the two main halves of the prayer Jesus taught.
1st half – God centered (Glory, holiness, name, kingdom, His will)
2nd half – human centered, needs, forgiveness
- What are the points of the popular 5 P's of prayer?
 - Praise – Honor God, focus on His holiness
 - Purpose – Align your desire w/His will
 - Provision – Asking for physical / material needs.
 - Pardon – Forgiveness / confessing sin
 - Protection – From temptation / from evil

- 6) Forgive debts / we forgive debtors – Mercy
- 7) Led not into temptation – Protection
- 8) Deliver from evil – Deliverance
