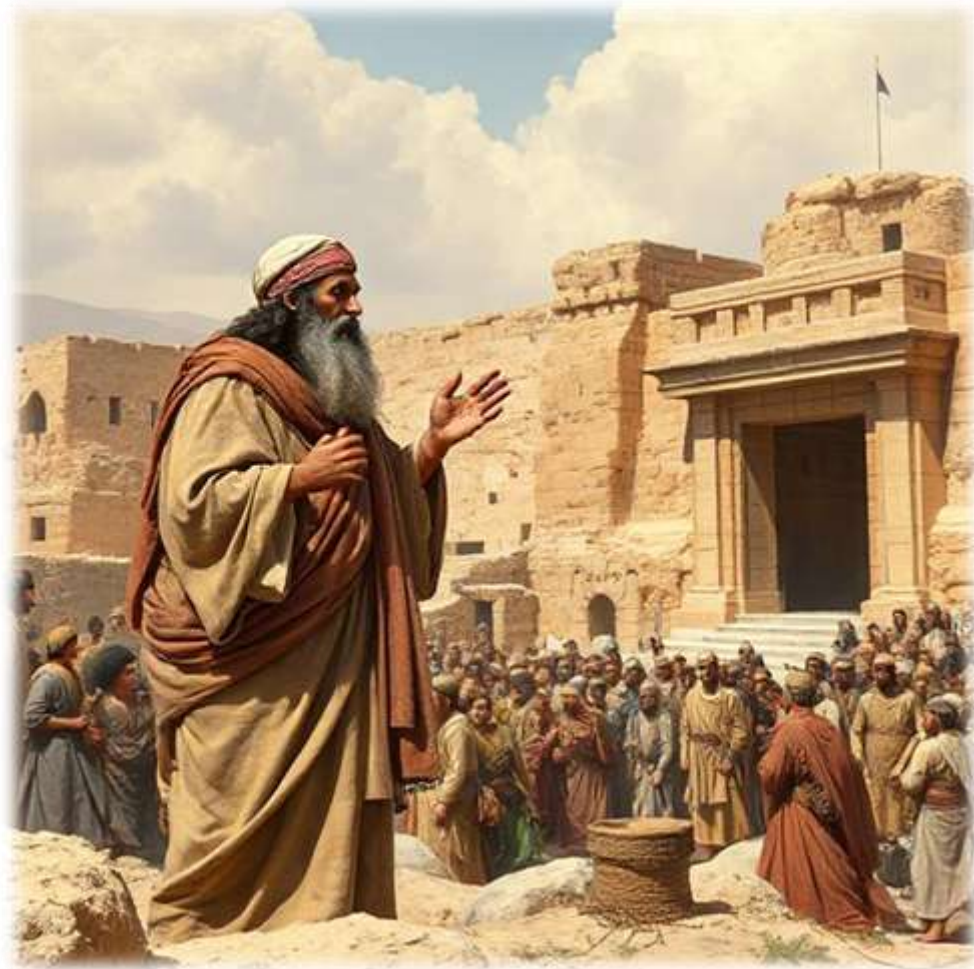


God's Prophets Warned

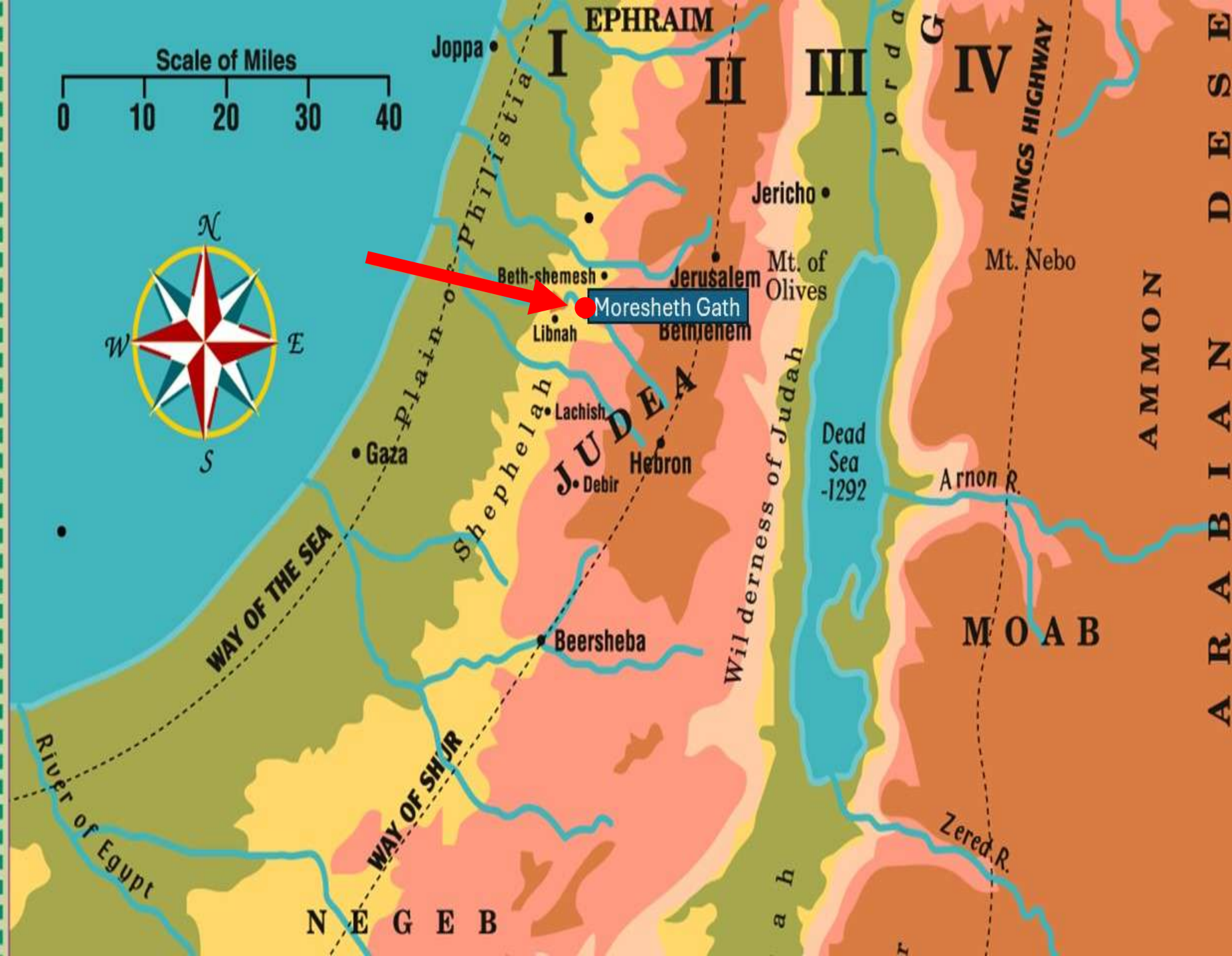

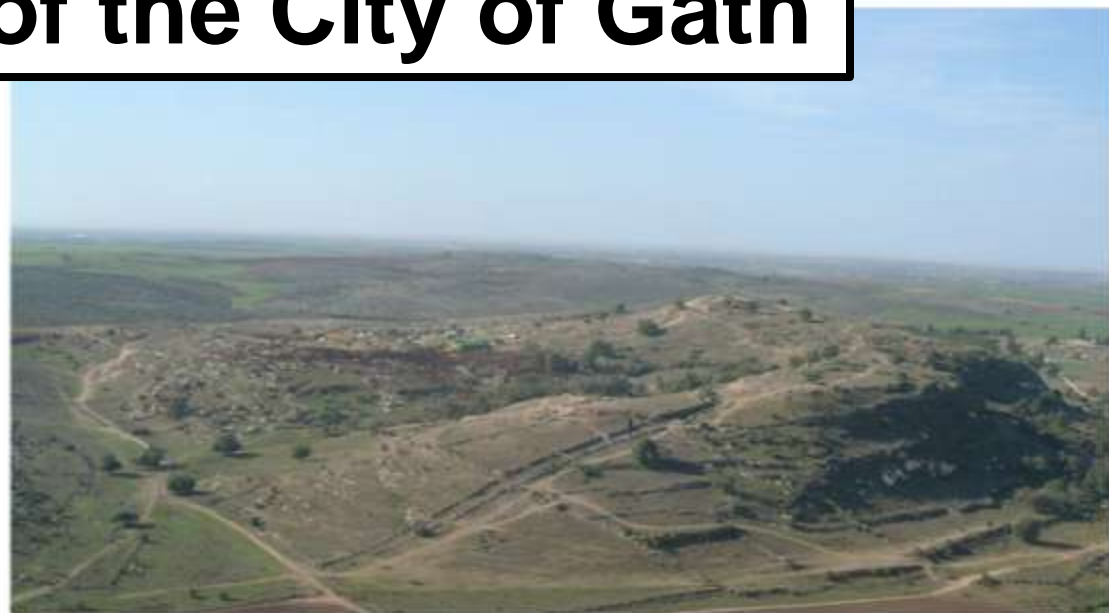

- How long did Micah served as a prophet?

Unknown – estimated approx 20-50 years

- Micah was born and lived near the city of Gath, what other historical Biblical characters / events occurred in this location?

1) Home of Goliath

2) David fled here twice from King Saul

3) The Ark of the Covenant was moved to Gath from Ashdod b/c Philistine illnesses

- What prophet was also warning the people during Micah's service?

Isaiah

- Although many prophets speak about the coming of the Messiah, what is unique about Micah's prophecies ?

Only old testament prophet to mention that Jesus will come from Bethlehem

•What item do modern Jews cast into a moving body of water on the first day of Jewish New Year (Rosh Hashanah)? Why?

Bread -

As a reminder that God's promise to cast all of their sins into the depth of the sea
