- (T/F) All four Gospels recorded the Sermon on the Mount, although some were very brief. **False – Only the book of Matthew and Luke exclusively recorded this event.**
- The Sermon on the Mount is also commonly known as? **Sermon on the Plain & The Beatitudes**
- (T/F) Luke never met Jesus. **True – His account was from careful historical research, eyewitness testimonies, and earlier written sources. He became a believer after Jesus' resurrection and spoke directly to the apostles**

- **Jesus' style of teaching at this event can also be described as? Why? Upside-down Kingdom**
Because Jesus' teaching was completely reverse of the worldly values then and now.
- **What did Jesus' woes actually mean?**
 - 1) Rich – refers to people whose wealth makes them self-sufficient**
 - 2) Full – complacent and spiritually apathetic**
 - 3) Laughing – condemns a superficial, trivial lifestyle that avoids the reality of sin**
 - 4) People speak well of you – those seeking universal approval compromises the truth.**
This is why false prophets are well liked

- What is a significant difference of Luke's account of the sermon from Matthew's?

Matthew features 8 distinct blessing written in third person...Luke mentioned 4.

- What metaphor did Jesus use on how one brother was judging another?

1) One about a brother wanting to remove a speck that is in his brother's eye but, Jesus suggested he should first remove the log from his own eye since he couldn't see past it.
