

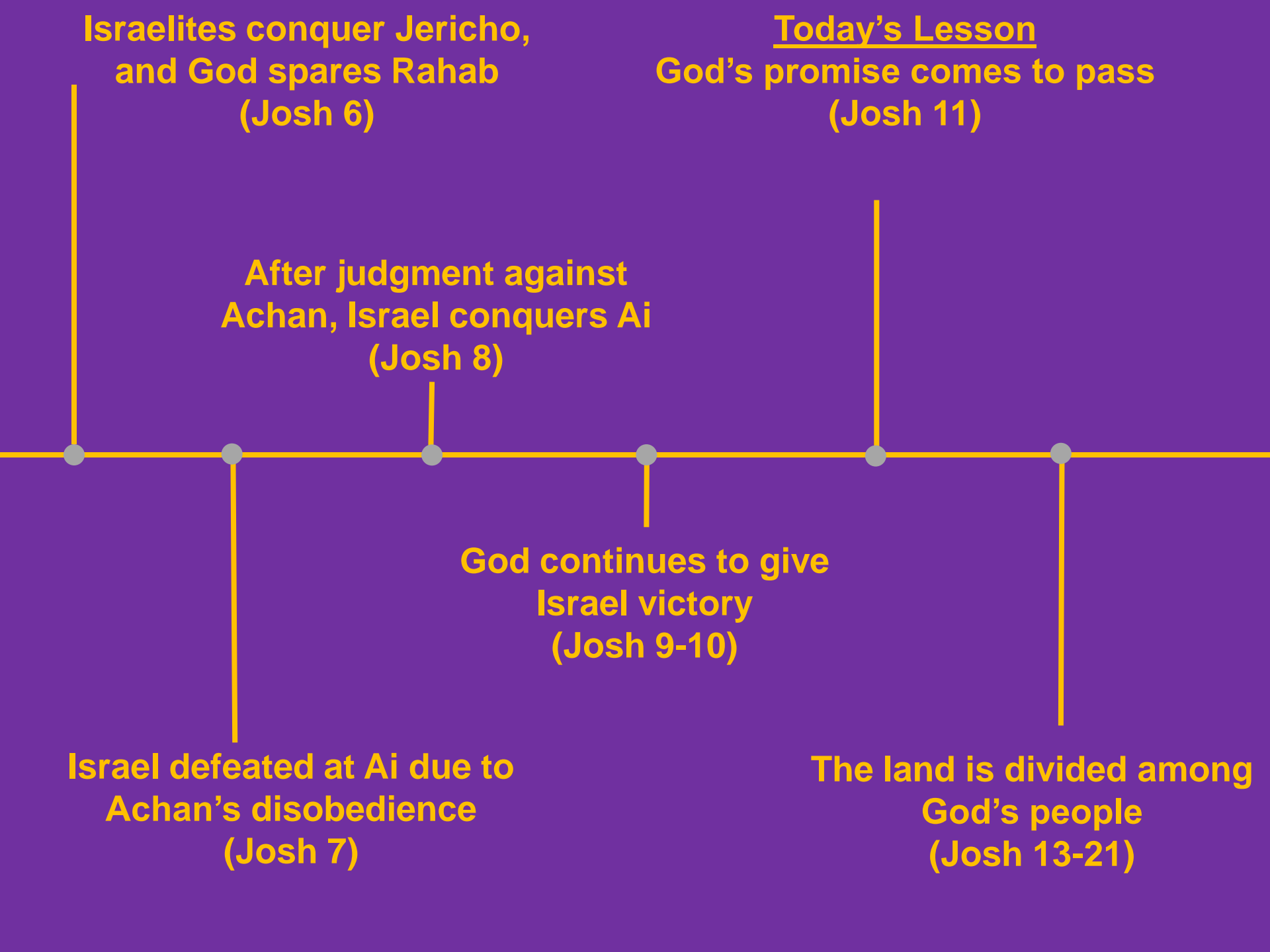

Josh 11:16-23

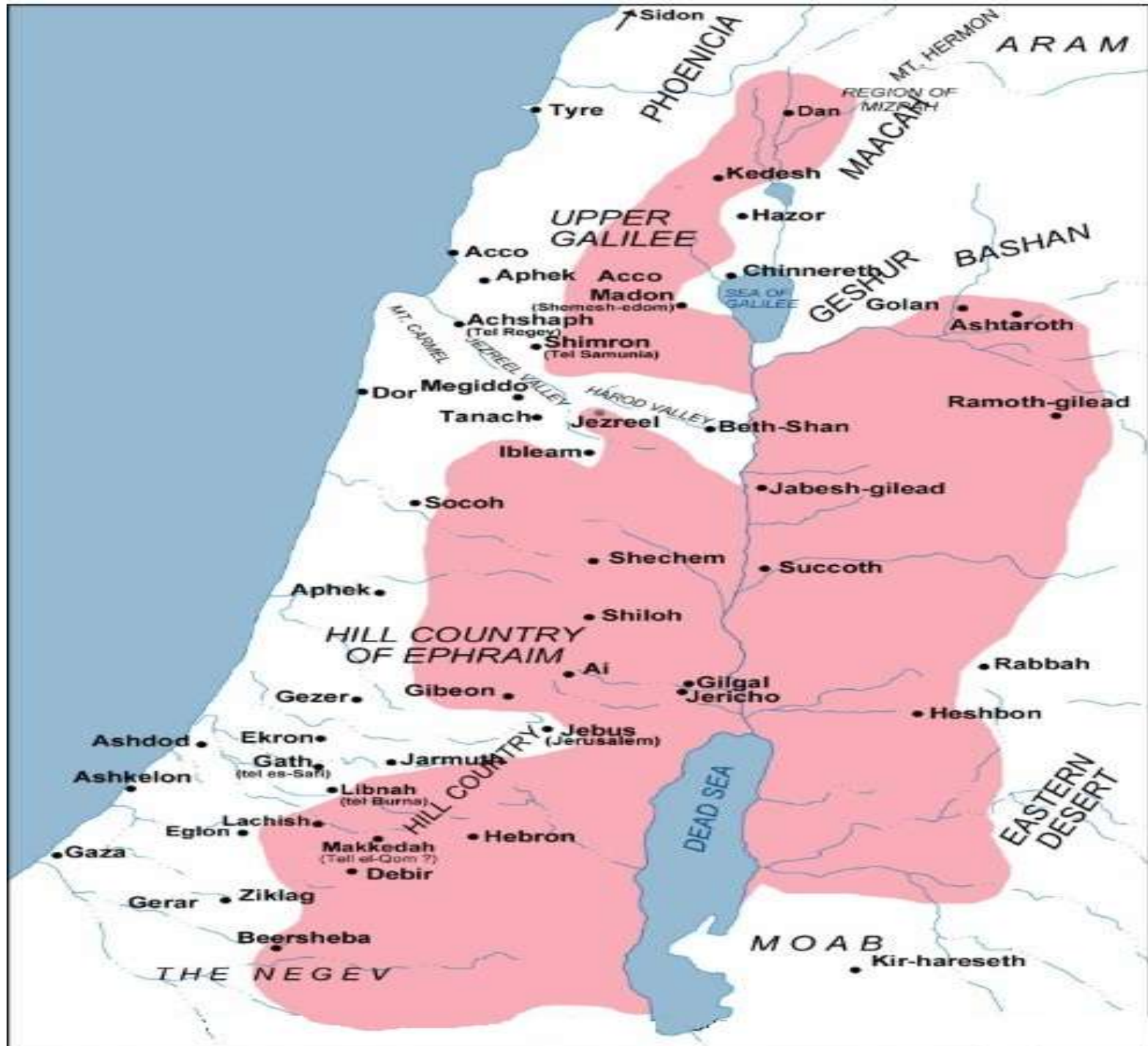


Key Concept

(Jebel Halaq)**



to ascent of Akrabbim and Tamar

to Mount Seir

**Nahal Zin
(Wadi el-Marra)**

to Kadesh-barnea

"...from Mount Halak, which rises toward Mount Seir" (Josh. 11:17; 12:7)

"And your border shall turn south of the ascent of Akrabbim, and cross to Zin, and its limit shall be south of Kadesh-barnea." (Num. 34:4 ; Josh. 15:3)

"On the south side, it shall run from Tamar as far as the waters of Meribah-kadesh." (Ezek. 47:19)

**For all the promises of God in
Him *are* Yes, and in Him Amen, to
the glory of God through us.**

2 Cor 1:20

- How many times did God promise the land of Canaan to the descendants of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob?

At least 55 times and 12 of those He stated the covenant was everlasting

- Who tricked the Israelites into a peace treaty? What became of them?

Gibeonites (Falahas “Beta Israel”)

Servants to the Levites – eventually migrated to Ethiopia

- How long between the time from God's initial promise to Abraham and Joshua's conquest? **Over 400 years**
- How many kings are listed as defeated in Joshua? **31 ~ each walled city-state had an estimated 1000-3000 people sometimes as few as 700.**

- What was the estimated size of the Anakim?

Approximately 9'

~ some records suggest maybe 7'- 8'6"

King Og's bed was 13.5 long x 6 ft wide

- How long did the conquest of Canaan by Joshua take?

Roughly seven years
