

to be honest about shortcomings and a acceptance that corrective action might need to be taken. In the project/programme environment this openness means allowing for an assurance function. The project team should regard the assurance function as a value-adding exercise and should welcome it as long as on a suitable scale. It is beneficial to use a lessons Learned Log throughout the projects lifecycle to capture lessons for future phases and for future projects within the organisation. The project has a forum for project / workstream managers to discuss challenges and share ideas (this may be within the project or between projects). Manage & Learne and the project or between projects.

Manage & Lead:
What's the difference?
