



Disability Tax Credit Forms

1. There is no fee to apply/submit an application to the Canada Revenue Agency, however your physician or nurse practitioner may charge a fee to fill out the medical portion (PART B) of the form (\$50-\$100).
2. Disability Tax Credit is for severe and prolonged impairments that affect daily living, not just for having a specific diagnosis. Please review [this questionnaire](#) before bringing the form into our office to confirm eligibility.
3. If denied, you have the right to request a second review or file an appeal.

Important Considerations Regarding Third-Party Agencies

1. Third-party agencies may require access to personal information, including your Social Insurance Number.
2. Some third-party agencies have been known to make false medical claims. If the CRA reviews the file and finds the information to be false, you are liable to repay all money received PLUS penalties.
3. Some third-party agencies provide legitimate help with Disability Tax Credit forms, but they do charge fees (sometimes 25%-40% of your total refund).
4. If you have hired a third-party agency and wish to stop working with them, you can contact the CRA at 1-800-959-8281 to remove authorization at any time.
