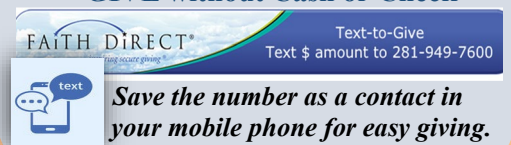

Stewardship Reflection

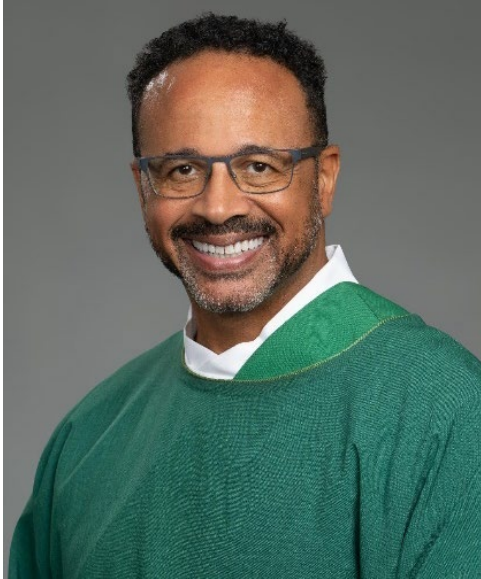

God Can Work in Unexpected Ways

Happy Sunday!

Today, we celebrate the last Sunday of Advent, a time of anticipation and reflection before Christmas. The Gospel introduces us to Mary, pregnant with Jesus, visiting her cousin Elizabeth, who is also expecting a miraculous child. This encounter reveals how God works in unexpected ways and invites us to say “yes” to His call, no matter how unprepared we might feel.

The first reading from Micah foretells Bethlehem as the birthplace of the Messiah. This small and seemingly insignificant town was chosen for a monumental purpose. Similarly, God chose King David, the youngest and least likely of Jesse’s sons, to be Israel’s greatest king. Both examples remind us that God doesn’t see as humans do; He looks into the heart and calls the least likely to do His greatest work.

This theme carries into the Gospel, where God uses Mary, a young virgin, and Elizabeth, an older woman thought to be barren, to bring forth Jesus and John the Baptist. Despite their circumstances, both women embraced God’s call with faith, allowing His plan to unfold through them.

What About Us?

God still calls us today. His call might be to serve as a Lector, sing in the choir, or care for someone in need. Often, we hesitate because we feel unqualified, fear others’ opinions, or think we’re too busy. Yet, as Mary and David show us, **God doesn’t call the perfect; He perfects the call.**

When Mary said “yes,” she opened the door for the

Savior of the world. Her willingness to trust God despite her fears changed history. What if she had said no? God’s plan invites each of us to participate, and our “yes” can have a profound impact we may never fully realize.

This Advent, consider how God might be calling you. Maybe He’s asking for something small but meaningful, or perhaps something that feels overwhelming. Trust that, like Mary and Elizabeth, God will work through you if you are willing.

A Prayerful Reflection

As we prepare for Christmas, let us remember that God calls us not because of our status, skills, or achievements, but because of our hearts. He works through us in unexpected ways, often when we feel least prepared.

When God reveals Himself and calls us, may we, like Mary, respond with a resounding “yes.” May this Christmas season inspire us to trust in His plan and embrace the unexpected ways He works in our lives.

May God bless you and your loved ones as we journey together toward the joy of Christmas.

Vatican Says No 'Yahweh' In Songs, Prayers at Catholic Masses

The Vatican has reiterated a directive that the name of God revealed in the tetragrammaton YHWH is not to be pronounced in Catholic liturgy or in music. Catholics at worship should neither sing nor pronounce the name of God as "Yahweh," the Vatican has said, citing the authority of Jewish and Christian traditions.

The instruction came in a June 29 letter to Catholic Bishops conferences around the world from the Vatican's top liturgical body, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Sacraments, by an explicit "directive" of Pope Benedict XVI. "In recent years, the practice has crept in of pronouncing the God of Israel's proper name," the letter noted, referring to the four-consonant Hebrew Tetragrammaton, YHWH.

That name is commonly pronounced as "Yahweh," though other versions include "Jaweh" and "Yehovah."

But such pronunciation violates long-standing Jewish tradition, the Vatican reminded bishops.

"As an expression of the infinite greatness and majesty of God, (the name) was held to be unpronounceable and hence was replaced during the reading of sacred Scripture by means of the use of an alternate name: 'Adonai,' which means 'Lord,'" the Congregation said.

That practice continued with Christianity, the letter explained, recalling the "church's tradition, from the beginning, that the sacred Tetragrammaton was never pronounced in the Christian context nor translated into any of the languages into which the Bible was translated."

Invoking the Vatican document from 2001, the Congregation reminded bishops that the name "Yahweh" in Catholic worship should be replaced by the Latin "Dominus" (Lord) or a word "equivalent in meaning" in the local language.

The Vatican's move will require changes in a number of hymns and prayers currently used in American churches, but not in the Mass itself, said the U.S. bishops' top liturgical official

The Catholic Church does not use the name "Yahweh" or "Jehovah" in Catholic liturgy for a number of reasons, including:

- **Jewish tradition**
The name was considered unpronounceable in Jewish tradition as a way to express God's majesty and greatness.
- **Preserving holiness**
The Catholic Church has traditionally used "the Lord" or equivalent to preserve God's holiness.
- **Early Christian practice**
Early Christians addressed God as "Lord" because the Greek translation of the Hebrew Scriptures replaced YHWH with the Greek word *kyrios*, which means "Lord".
- **Jesus's practice**
Jesus, a pious Jewish man, would not have addressed God as Yahweh in public. Instead, he used the term "Abba", which is a familiar form of "Father".
- **Avoiding the tetragrammaton YHWH**
The Catholic Church does not use the tetragrammaton YHWH in liturgical celebrations, songs, or prayers. This is due to Jewish tradition, which holds that the name was unpronounceable to express God's majesty and greatness. The name was replaced with "Adonai," which means "Lord".
- **Using "Jehovah". Not transliterating the divine name**
The Catholic Church does not transliterate the divine name in liturgical texts and translations. Instead, it uses "the Lord" or an equivalent to preserve the holiness of God.
