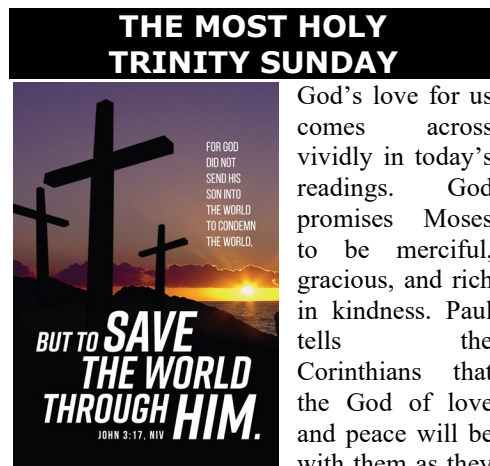

Some reflections inspired by online copyrighted commentaries and homilies

Solemnity Of The Most Holy Trinity (Cycle A)

The celebration of the Solemnity of the Trinity is an invitation to enter into the Mystery of God. The nature of his being consubstantial with the Son and the Holy Spirit

As we progress through the liturgical year we take in turn the wonderful sayings and miracles of Christ, we will contemplate the great events of salvation, the birth of Christ, the Last Supper, his passion and death, his resurrection and ascension into heaven, the birth of the Church at Pentecost, the Eucharist on Corpus Christi. But today we contemplate the greatest mystery of all, the Blessed Trinity, the source of all that was, is and is to come. We began Mass today as we begin every prayer or liturgical celebration, In the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. +

Today we contemplate the inner mystery of God himself. We contemplate —what else can we do in the face of God but contemplate. To contemplate is to turn our gaze on him, to empty our hearts and minds of all other thoughts. In contemplation we become aware of his majesty, his glory, and wonder at his greatness and the extraordinary depth of his love.

We like to belong to our family, our parish, our community. Not only that, but we also need to belong in family of our God. We should make earnest efforts to belong to Jesus. Since the day you were baptized you belong to the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. How privileged you are to grow up in such a beautiful family. Turn to the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in prayer every day. You belong to their family.

This Sunday, as the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we are presented with a remarkably familiar and famous passage from the Gospel of John (3:16). God, who is love itself, sent his only Son into the world to physically reveal his love to us. When we reflect on the Holy Trinity, we realize that we can never fully understand this eternal mystery. Our celebration today, however, acknowledges our commitment not only to embrace this central mystery of our Christian faith but also to imitate the actions of our loving God in gratitude for all that God – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – has done for our salvation.

Jesus came and we knew through his prayers and instructions that there were two persons in God. Before Jesus ascended, he promised the Holy Spirit who came at Pentecost and then we knew there were three persons in God. God is a Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is the happiest of families. They are totally united in love for each other. The Father loves the Son, and the Son loves the Father. I like to call this love between the Father for the Son, and the pure love of the Son for the Father, the Holy Spirit.

We take it for granted and readily profess that there are three persons in one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. When we come together to pray, whether for mass and the celebration of the sacraments or the less formal and more private moments of prayer and devotion, we always celebrate and profess our common trinitarian faith that acknowledges One God in Three Persons.

The foundation of our faith in God and our profession of God as a Trinity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit reaches its highpoint in the event of Jesus Christ, whose life, words, and actions reveal the relationship of three persons in one God. Through Jesus Christ, you and I are brought into that same loving and life-giving relationship with our God. Saint Paul tells the Romans in a letter and us that “those who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God” (Romans 8:14). Having received the Spirit of adoption, that Spirit gives us not only the confidence to call on God as “Father” but also the courage to align and join ourselves with Christ in both his suffering and his glorification.

Today, in praise and adoration of God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, we pray that He who unites us to himself will continue to protect and guide us and bring us all more deeply into His divine life. May the God of perfect relationship strengthen our relationship with Him and with one another and strengthen our witness to His presence and saving power in our world.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and every shall be, world without end. Amen

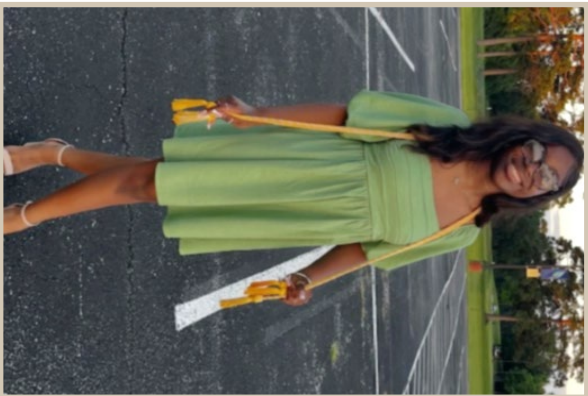

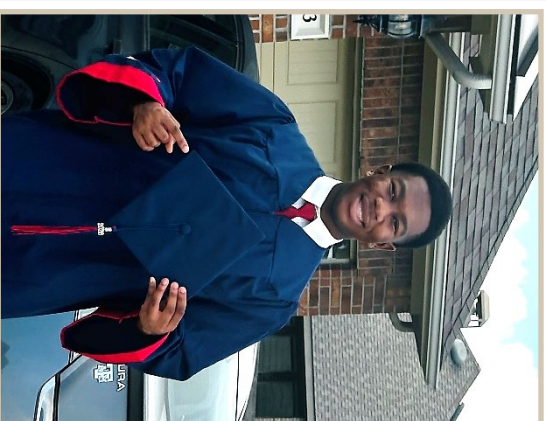

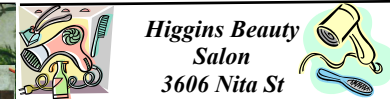
