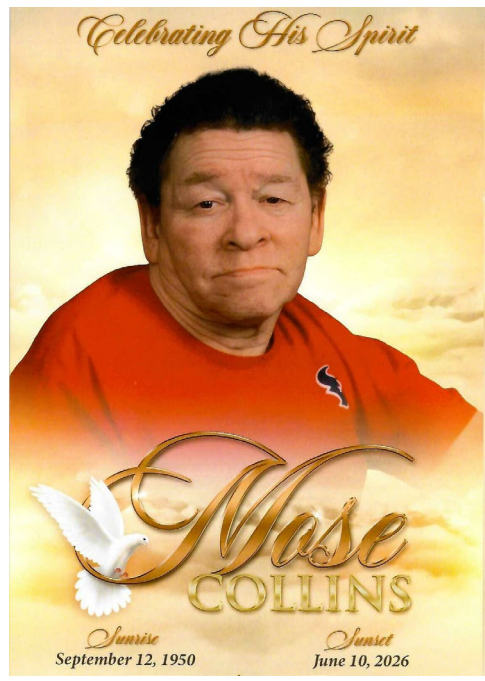

TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A)

Jesus said to the Twelve: **“Whoever denies Me before others, I will deny before my Heavenly Father.”**
Matthew 10:33

Divine lessons for us, that Jesus taught the Apostles

In today’s Gospel reading, Jesus is speaking to His twelve Apostles. Let’s listen to some practical lessons taught by our Lord and Savior in these eight verses of Matthew **10:26-33**.

1. Your private life must be reconciled to your public life. Jesus said, **“What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops”** (V. 27). Are you doing something in private that you would not want shouted from the housetops? As Christians, we should realize that integrity begins at home and in our private lives. The word “reconcile” in this context means “to be in agreement” or “to harmonize”. Why is this important? Jesus said, **“Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known”** (cf. Mt. 10:26). It’s stressful to live a lie, when people think you are good and morally upright, but at home you behave sinfully. There was a period in my life when I appeared holy at church while disrespecting my mother at my home. My private life **contradicted** my public walk with Christ. The great evangelist D.L. Moody said, **“A Christian is what he is in the dark.”** What Jesus did in secret, He also did publicly.

2. Your number one priority is to get your soul right with God. **“And do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna”** (V. 28). Why? Because God alone determines the eternal destiny of our souls. **Parents, the greatest gift you can give to your children is the example of a Christ-centered life.** St. Paul said, **“Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ”** (I Cor. 11:1). It is essential that you teach your children how to communicate with God, just as Jesus taught His disciples to pray (cf. Mt. 6:5-15). I often saw my father listening to God by daily reading of the Scriptures. Many young people today do not know how to communicate with God. They can quote entire rap songs, yet cannot recite **the Lord’s Prayer!** I especially notice this when young people serve as pallbearers at funerals. The pallbearers usually represent the future and the strength of the family. When the Lord’s Prayer is recited, some simply bow their heads because they

don’t know it! How can someone memorize an entire rap song, but not know the prayer that our Lord taught us? It has to do with our priority.

3. Do not deny God by your actions. **“Whoever denies Me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father”** (V.33). I never heard my father tell my mother that he loved her. I also cannot remember hearing him say to me, **“I love you, son.”** Yet I knew without question that he loved us. How did I know? He showed his love through his actions. He was a quiet man. I never witnessed him being abusive or disrespectful to my mother or me. He provided for his family and lived an upright and honest life. Jesus said, **“This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me”** (Matt. 15:8).

A baseball player hit a home run. The ball sailed into the center-field seats. As he rounded the bases-first, second, third, and home-the umpire **called him out.** The player protested, **“How can I be out and I just hit a home run?”** The umpire replied, **“You touched second base, third base, and home plate, but you missed first base. Therefore, you’re out.”** During the Easter season, we learned how Jesus **unquestionably hit the ultimate home run** through His death on Calvary and His resurrection on the third day. Now it’s time for us **to run the bases:**

- (1) **“Are you making Jesus Christ Lord of your life, both publicly and privately?”**
- (2) **“Is getting your soul right with God your number one priority?”**
- (3) **“Do your actions show that you love the Lord, or are they denying Him? Part of our**



salvation is up **to us.** Do not be called **out** by Our Heavenly Father, when you reach Home Plate-the Judgement Seat of Christ.

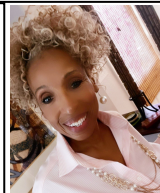
