
True joy in the Lord compels us to give back and share what we have. When we *Cry Out with Joy to the Lord!* we are inspired to open our hearts and

# FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT (A)

# **Turn Toward God in Imperfect Circumstances**

Brothers and Sisters, Happy Sunday! As we arrive at the final Sunday of Advent, our readings remind us that faith is not lived in perfect situations. Faith is lived where life is uncertain, confusing, and sometimes painful. The Scriptures give us three figures, Ahaz, Joseph, and John the Baptist, each facing imperfect circumstances, each forced to choose whether they would turn toward God or away from Him.

King Ahaz is surrounded by enemy nations and filled with fear. God sends Isaiah to encourage him and even invites Ahaz to ask for a sign of reassurance. But Ahaz refuses. His doubt leads him to turn away from God's invitation. Yet God remains faithful and promises the sign that will one day point to the Messiah: "The virgin shall conceive...Emmanuel."

Joseph, 700 years later, receives that same promise in real time. He learns that Mary, his beloved, is with child. A confusing, painful, imperfect situation. But when the angel speaks God's message, Joseph chooses faith over fear. He turns toward God and embraces the role God prepared for him. Joseph shows us that even when circumstances are uncertain, grace is available when we turn toward the Lord.

And then we see, (from last Sunday's Gospel), John the Baptist, sitting in prison, awaiting his fate. Even John has a moment of doubt and sends his disciples to ask Jesus: "Are you the one who is to come?" John does not hide his doubt; he brings it to Jesus. He turns toward God, not away, and Jesus strengthens him with reassurance.

These three figures speak to our own lives. We all face seasons of uncertainty:

- Why is my family struggling?
- Why am I sick?
- Why did my relationship fall apart?
- Why can't I find peace?
- Why did my loved one die so soon?

In those moments, the enemy whispers discouragement. But Advent teaches us that God enters our imperfect situations with perfect love. Emmanuel, *God-with-us*, comes precisely where life is messy.

So the invitation this week is simple:


Whatever your circumstances, turn toward God.

Turn toward Him in prayer.
Turn toward Him in Scripture.
Turn toward Him in the sacraments.
Turn toward Him when doubts appear.

Like Joseph and John the Baptist, bring your fears and questions to God. He will meet you with grace, strength, and peace.

As we prepare for Christmas, may you experience the hope and comfort of Emmanuel...God with us in every circumstance.


