Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand and we boast in our hope of sharing the glory of God. But not only that, but we also boast in our sufferings, because that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us. For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly, rarely will anyone die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person someone might actually dare to die. But God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us. Much more surely then, now that we have been justified by his blood, will we be saved through him from the wrath of God. *Romans 5:1-8 (NRSV)*

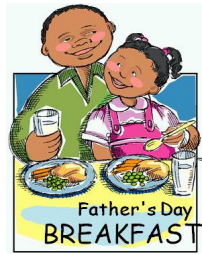

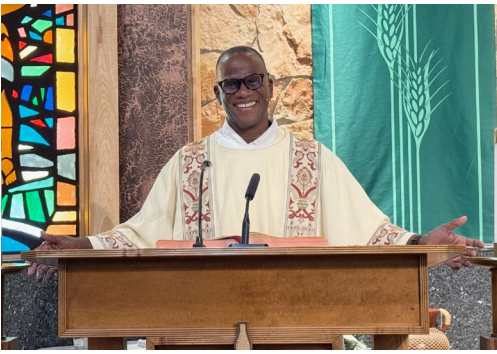

## THE MOST HOLY TRINITY(c)

June 15, 2025

*Jesus said, "...When **He** comes, the **Spirit** of truth, **He** will guide you to all truth. Everything that the **Father** has is Mine. John 16:13, 15*

### We are secure within The Holy Trinity!

Today is the solemnity of the **Most Holy Trinity**, which is **central** to the Christian Faith. The **Catholic Encyclopedia** defines the **Trinity** as: *"the truth that in the unity of the Godhead there are Three Persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, these Three Persons being truly distinct from one another. The Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God, and yet there are not three Gods **but one God.**"*

After learning how to ride my two-wheeled "banana seat" bike; when I was around 7 or 8 years old, my Dad showed me how to care for it. He explained that I needed oil to lubricate the moving parts, oil to keep the chain clean, and oil to prevent rust from forming on the chain. Thinking that I needed three different oils to accomplish these tasks; my Dad introduced me to **3 in 1 oil**. It was **three different oils**, that performed **three or more different functions**; yet it was blended into **one oil**.



The word **Trinity** is not in the Bible, but the **concept of the Trinity** starts in **Genesis 1**. *"In the beginning when **God created...**"* (Genesis 1:1)-that's God the Father. *"And a **mighty wind** [the Spirit of God] sweeping over the waters"* (Genesis 1:2)-that's the Spirit. *"And **God said...**"* (Genesis 1:3).

The Word of God, we find out in John 1, is **Jesus, the Son of God. The 3 Persons of the Trinity:**

**(1) God the Father** initiates contact with us. Jesus said, *"No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him"* John 6:44. God attracts us to Himself **so we can know Him and His Son.**

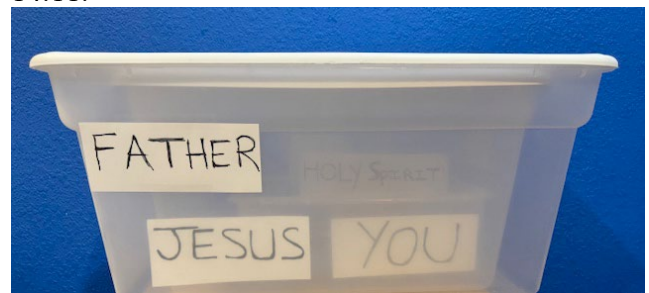
**(2) For us to please God the Father**, we have to be like **God the Son**. In **Matthew 3:17**, God the Father proclaimed (from heaven), *"This is My Beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."*

If you want to please God-you need to imitate His Son. Imitate the way the Son treated people imitate His walk, imitate His character, imitate His talk, imitate His actions toward people who hated Him. This is Father's Day weekend. **Men the greatest gift you can give your family, your spouse, your children, and siblings is to be a good example of Christ.** The Apostle Paul said, *"Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ"* 1 Cor. 11:1.

**(3) God the Holy Spirit** comes upon us to **fill and empower us**. Jesus declared in Acts 1:8, *"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you...."* We need the **Power of the Holy Spirit** to do everything that God has called us to do. We are **secure and sealed** within the Most Holy Trinity. Let me illustrate: I have a clear storage container labeled **"You"**. This container represents baptized Christians. I place another container inside the **You** container.

This container is the **Holy Spirit** which indwells the Christian (cf. 1 Cor. 6:19). I now take the **You and the Holy Spirit containers** and place them in the **Jesus** container; because Jesus said:

*"You are in me"* (John 14:20). Finally, I place all of the containers in the large container labeled, **Father**; because Jesus declares, *"Believe Me that I am in the Father"* Jn 14:11.



My Dad had a tradition at our home. Before he would turn into bed, he would lock and secure all of the doors and windows in the house. Then he would come to my Mother and say, "Everything is locked up, I am going to bed."

As a **child**, I never feared that someone would break in on us while we slept because my earthly Father said he had secured the house. As a **child** of our Heavenly Father, you should begin to **see yourself secure and safe within the Most Holy Trinity!**
