
Stewardship Reflection

Love in Spite Of, Not Because Of

Happy Sunday! In today's Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples, "I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." That's not just a suggestion; it's a call to a different kind of love. Not a "because of" love, but an "in spite of" love.

Too often, we love people *because of* something, because they treat us well, because they agree with us, because they fit neatly into our world. But Jesus doesn't love like that. Jesus loves in *spite of*; in spite of betrayal, in spite of denial, in spite of sin.

Brothers and sisters, think about it...He washed Judas' feet, knowing Judas was about to betray Him. He welcomed Peter back, even after Peter denied Him three times. That's agape love, which is unconditional, sacrificial, and undeserved.

And that's the love we are called to show.

Why? Because that's how God loves *us*. We weren't created out of obligation; we were created out of love. God didn't have to make us, but He wanted relationship with us. And not just with *Him*, but with *each other*. We were made to be in communion, to love and be loved.

Jesus says, "This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." Not by how holy we look, or how much we know, but by how we love. Real love. In spite of love. So how do we live that out?

First, **remember how God loves you**. He didn't wait for you to be perfect. He loved you at your worst and still does. Let that humble you and soften your heart toward others.

Second, <u>choose</u> love, even when you don't feel it. "Agape" love isn't a feeling; it's a decision. You won't always feel like forgiving, or listening, or being kind, but love shows up anyway.

And third, **stay in community.** God didn't create just one person. He made us for relationship. Church isn't just about coming to Mass; it's about growing in love together. That's where we practice patience, mercy, and grace. Our world is filled with conditional love; love that divides, judges, and disappears when things get hard. But we are called to something better. When we love in spite of, we reflect the heart of Jesus, and we give the world a glimpse of God.

Let's be that kind of community at St. Francis Xavier. Let's love not, because it's easy, but because it's who we're called to be. In spite of. Not because of. Just like Jesus.






