

May 11, 2025

Jesus said, "My sheep hear My voice; I know them, and they follow Me."

John 10:27

God speaks to us in different ways; please know them and respond!

Jesus, the Good Shepherd calls us His sheep because He carefully guides and protects us



so we might enter into eternal life with Him. We shouldn't box the Risen Lord in and expect Him to communicate in only one way.

We must know His teaching methods and respond by following Him (cf. John 10:27).

- 1. The Lord speaks through His Word (Scripture, the Bible). Jesus is the Word. "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God." "And the Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us" (John 1:1, 14). The wrong response to the Word is to harden your heart (Hebrews 3:15).
- 2. God speaks to us through people. That includes your spouse, children, and even your enemies! On a domestic violence scene, I witnessed a little boy telling his abused Mother, "Momma, let's go, we have to leave. He's going to hurt you again!" That boy spoke to his Mother like a prophet. I could see that God had placed an urgency on that child for them to leave that location. She however was dragging her feet, not realizing the danger she and her son were in. God may speak to you through people you least expect.
- 3. God communicates through nature. Jesus used flowers in a pasture to teach His disciples (and us) not to worry because fear and anxiety are deadly. "So why do you worry about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin. Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will He not much more clothe you, O you of little faith?" Matt. 6:28-31.
- 4. God may use situations or circumstances to warn us, that we are not right with Him. It may

be a horrific car accident or a health scare that you survived. I had just concluded a gravesite Rite of Committal. As I headed back to my car, I told a man who had attended the funeral, "God bless you, my brother." He responded, by saying, "Yes, I know God has blessed me."

In the middle of the cemetery, he unbuttoned his shirt for me to see an open heart surgery scar. He said, "God got my attention, and I serve Him every day!" When God uses a frightful situation in your life, learn to stop and say, "Speak Lord for Your servant is listening!"

5. God communicates with us through the Holy Spirit. Jesus said in John 14:26, "The Holy Spirit. Jesus said in John 14:26, "The Holy Spirit...will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you." My Mom was bedridden during the last year of her life. She would call me to her room, but sometimes I wouldn't hear her. I purchased a baby monitor to solve the problem. The monitor, was by her bed and I carried the transmitter. When she would call, I would push the transmitter button and talk to her. One day, I was cutting grass, and I noticed Mom hadn't called me in a while. I ran inside the house and discovered she needed my help; her bed needed changing.

She told me, "Mike I called you, but you never came." I felt so bad. I apologized and cleaned her up. After she was nice and comfortable, I checked the transmitter on my belt loop to see why didn't I hear her. I had the volume turned

down! The Holy Spirit speaks to our heart (the transmitter) and it's up to us to tune out the distractions of life and listen so we can hear Him and respond.

Even though Mom has died, I still have



the baby monitoring system. It commemorates the love and special bond we had for each other, but it also reminds me to always be alert when the Holy Spirit speaks. Mom, continue to rest well in the Kingdom of Heaven!
