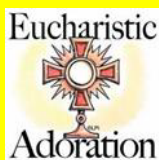

## EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A)

"Those who ate were about five thousand men, not counting women and children."  
Matthew 14:21

### Life Lessons from a Miracle

The feeding of the five thousand is the only public miracle recorded in all **four Gospels**, though the **Resurrection** of Jesus is also found in all four. What is the Holy Spirit trying to teach us? **Matthew's account** (Matt. 14:13-21) reveals at least **three important life lessons**. Jesus had been teaching the crowd and when evening came, the disciples told Jesus to dismiss them so they could go into the villages and buy food for themselves. Jesus said to them, **"There is no need for them to go away; give them some food yourselves."** They told Him, **"Five loaves and two fish are all we have here"**—Matt. 14:17. Where did the food come from? **John 6:8** tells us that the five loaves and two **small** fish came from **a boy in the crowd**. Matthew's Gospel explicitly states that women and children were excluded from the count of the 5,000 men. Ironically, the one who was **not even counted** became an essential part of the miracle.

**Lesson 1: Your blessing, your miracle, your answer to prayer, may come from the hands of someone you may not have considered important!** A widow was sitting in church listening to Christmas carols which were being sung by the choir before Midnight Mass. She was crying because this was the first Christmas without her husband sitting beside her in the pew. A couple with their child came and sat beside the grieving widow. Minutes later, the widow felt someone holding her hand. It was the child who was sitting beside her. Seeing his new friend crying, he simply reached over and held her hand. That widow later said, "the child holding my hand was the best Christmas gift ever!" My Mom tells the story of how her father abandoned the entire family when she was a little girl. Many years later, I witnessed my Mom take food to her Father (my Grandfather) because he had nothing to eat. **God may feed you by the hands of someone you thought had no value.** Some people think they have a license to treat others any kind of way or say, "this is who I am" or "this is how I am made." Then your **heart needs to change.**

That's why Jesus said, **"You have to be born again, if not you cannot see the Kingdom of God"** John 3:3. Matthew 14:19 says: "Jesus ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass."

**Lesson 2: Before you can truly experience the blessings from heaven, allow Jesus to call your life into order.** Jesus brought order to the crowd, by having them to sit, then He performed the miracle. You must first bring order and discipline into your life to support the weight of God's blessings. As a young man, I couldn't experience the blessings of God, because my spending and buying habits were out of control! It's interesting that a third of lottery winners end up in bankruptcy court within 3-5 years of their big win. Why? They had no discipline in place. Can you support the responsibilities of having millions of dollars? Someone spoke truth into my life and introduced the Biblical principle of "tithing" to me. It brought discipline into my life and now I can truly experience God's blessings. Matthew 14:19 continues by saying: "Jesus said the blessing, broke the loaves..." **Lesson 3: Be thankful to God, even when what you have seems insufficient.** Jesus thanked God for the 5 loaves and two fish; even though the loaves and fish were not nearly enough to feed the multitude. Biblical scholars estimate a total of **fifteen to twenty thousand people** when women and children are included! During my Mom's final visit to the optometrist, he explained to her that he couldn't do anything else for her eyes. Her eyesight was reduced to a blurry vision. We prayed in the car before we headed home. After praying, she shouted,



"Thank you, dear Jesus, **—I can still see!**" She didn't complain about all of the eyesight she had lost. Instead, she thanked God for the **little vision** she still had. Stop complaining about what you do not have and thank God for what He has already given you, regardless of the amount!
