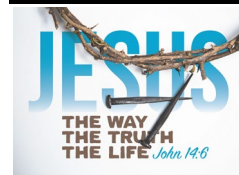

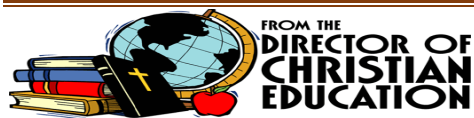

Need Not be Present to Win

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER (A)

Jesus said to him [Thomas], **“I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”** John 14:6

How can we expect to live with the Father in Heaven if we reject His Son here on earth?



Jesus' words to Thomas are direct and unmistakable: “No one comes to the Father except through me.” Let me illustrate this **truth** with an event that actually occurred.

Darryl Woods was a dear friend of mine at the Houston Police Department. We were patrol partners and remained close friends for many years. Darryl was from Memphis, Tennessee, and he often returned home to visit his parents and siblings. He would invite me to come along, saying I needed to broaden my horizons by traveling farther east than Louisiana—the furthest I had ever been. One year, I accepted the invitation and drove to Memphis with Darryl, his wife Paula, and their two young sons. We took turns driving, and I handled the final stretch. With Darryl in the front seat, he guided me every step of the way until we arrived at his parents' beautiful two-story home. When we pulled up, Darryl's father came out to greet us on the front porch. Paula and the boys went inside first. Darryl and his father embraced warmly, and then he introduced me. I extended my hand, but instead of shaking it, his father wrapped his arms around me in a hug, just as he had done with his son. Inside, we sat together and talked. To my surprise, he seemed to know quite a bit about me. He asked, “I understand you take care of your Mother?” “Yes sir”, I replied. “And you don't mistreat people, use profanity or abuse your authority while on patrol?” “No sir,” I answered again. “That's what I taught, my son, Darryl!” he said. Later, as we gathered for supper, Darryl asked, “Where is Michael going to sit?” His father pointed and said, “Right there”. Let's reflect on this illustration: **The only reason I was in the father's house was because of my close and personal relationship with his son!** Are you in a close and personal relationship with the Son, Jesus Christ? I would not have even found the father's house if the son had not been sitting beside me, guiding me along the way. Why did the father embrace me as he did his own son? Because I reminded him of his son—we shared similar






























character traits. Do you remind our Heavenly Father of His Son, in whom He is well pleased (cf. Matthew 3:17)? How did the father know about me—how I lived, how I treated others, how I cared for my mother? His son had told him. In the same way, Jesus sits at the right hand of the Father, interceding for us (cf. Romans 8:34). What does Jesus say to the Father about you? Without the intercession of Jesus Christ, none of us would enter Heaven. Why was a seat prepared for me at the supper table? Because the son told his father that a special guest was coming. “Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb” (Revelation 19:9).

Jesus said, “One of you will betray Me” (Matthew 26:21). One by one, the Apostles asked, “**Lord is it, I?**” When it came to Judas, he asked, “**Rabbi is it I?**” Judas did not acknowledge **Jesus as Lord**; he saw **Him only as a teacher**. We must have **faith and recognize** Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, surrendering our **whole** lives to Him—our past, our present, and our future—in order to spend **eternity** with the Father and His Son. Darryl and I remained close friends even after we retired. We made it a point to have a meal together at least once a year. Today, both **Darryl and his father have died**, but I thank



God for the **spiritual lessons** they taught me through their lives. Each of us should ask: **How can we expect to live with the Father in Heaven, if we reject His Son here on earth?**
