## Bio of Rev. Henry J. Davis, SSJ



Fr. Davis is the pastor of Corpus Christi- Epiphany Church in New Orleans and the Chief Religious Officer of St. Augustine High School. He continues to serve the Society of St. Joseph of the Sacred Heart, "The Josephites".

Fr. Davis has been a member of the Josephites for 25 years, and an ordained priest for more than 24 years. He is a Fourth Degree Knight of St. Peter Claver and a Fourth Degree Knight of Columbus. He celebrated his silver jubilee on May 15, 2018.

Prior to his current assignment, he was pastor of Our Mother of Mercy Church, Church Point, Louisiana. He was elected Area Director for

Louisiana until his reassignment to his home city of New Orleans.

Fr. Davis was the former Director of St. Joseph the Worker House of Formation in Iperu Remo, Nigeria and has taught many young religious how to be faithful to God in a religious vocation.

He was the former Area Director for Texas and California while serving as pastor of Our Mother of Mercy and Blessed Sacrament Churches in Beaumont. He is also the former Texas State Chaplain for the Knights and Ladies of St. Peter Claver and is a Texas State 100 club member.


Fr. Davis assisted the Diocese of Beaumont with activities dealing with African American Catholics, Catholic Schools, conferences with Youth and Campus Ministry workshops with Catechists.

Fr. Davis is a life member of the NAACP and has managed many projects in parishes across the country.

Growing up in the Josephite Parish of St. Peter Claver Church and attending St. Peter Claver School, Fr. Davis, SSJ acquired his knowledge of faith and Catholic education in God in the city of New Orleans. He was touched by the generosity of the priests and brothers of the Josephites and the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament and decided that he wanted to dedicate his life to the evangelization of African American

Fr. Davis matriculated his whole life in Catholic schools and universities. He is a graduate of Xavier University of New Orleans (1988) and has received his graduate degree from DeSales School of Theology (1993) formerly located on the campus of Catholic University in Washington, D.C. Fr. Davis is pursuing his doctorate in African American Religious Social Issues & Education.


