Pastor's Reflection

WHO DO YOU SAY THAT I AM? (CONT'D)

Last week we reflected on our personal answer to who Jesus is. We talked about some seeing Him as a miracle worker, or someone who forgives and only wants our good. Some see him as the one who has authority to tell us how to live our lives and wants us to spend eternity with Him. We spoke about Peter's insightful answer and how it was revealed to him by God.

Today we reflect on Peter's answer. According to Jesus, Peter answered correctly that he (Jesus) is the Christ (Messiah). But what did Peter mean by saying that Jesus is the Christ? From what he had witnessed Jesus was anointed to be King. The Messiah who, according to the Prophets and Old Testament writings, would come and rescue God's people from servitude, especially from the Romans. From the Jewish tradition, Jesus would establish a kingdom in which there would be no poor or sick or blind or lame. This had been prophesied by Isaiah and the other prophets. The Messianic kingdom would be run on the principles of justice and fairness. Living under the guidance of the beatitudes, bad and evil people would turn their lives around. Jesus is the realization of the Anointed One, the expected High Priest or Judge and the great warrior.

With this understanding, Peter and the other Apostles saw themselves as being in the presence of greatness, and each was destined to have a high and influential position in God's kingdom. They were, therefore, excited about finding that Jesus was the "Messiah", the one who would rule Israel and the whole world.

It is with this understanding that Peter responded to Jesus immediately after he started telling the disciples that the "Messiah" had to suffer and die. The expectation of the "Messiah" was that he would be powerful enough to overcome any threat against him. Jesus had to tell Peter to "get lost" for what he was doing was a temptation. He was not listening to what Jesus was saying. Logically speaking, what Peter said makes sense as opposed to what Jesus was saying.




In fact, there are a lot of things about our faith that do not measure-up to logical sense. For example, what logical sense does it make to deny oneself and take up a cross to follow Jesus? Again, how does one find life after losing it? What is empirically good in loving your enemies and forgiving them? The Communion we partake tastes like unleavened bread and wine, yet we claim it the Body and Blood of Christ. Then, we are to give our hard-earned money to the less fortunate.

Like Jeremiah in our first reading, and Peter, many of us are excited when we first hear our call to minister in the Lord's vineyard. We are thrilled, but we do not reflect on the implications of what the calling is about. Like Jeremiah and Peter, we listen to the calls with our own preconceived understanding. And we complain that fidelity to the Lord brings misery when people react to our ministry when our pleas are rejected, and people call us unpatriotic and hypocrites. People may mock us continually and we are tempted to look back at our calling as seduction or being lured or tricked into a thankless responsibility. Like Jeremiah, we find ourselves in the middle of thankfulness and hate. We do not stand a chance of living a different life.

We like Jeremiah may feel compelled to prophesy "violence" and "destruction" and for that we will be ostracized and rejected. We may wish for an easy and pleasing message to prophesy, but it would be to no avail. We hear Jesus teaching us that we, his followers, must also follow the same pattern of his and expose temptations from Satan which reject our calling.

So, as we take time to reflect on our own answer to the question: "who do you say that I am?", we can hear Jesus telling us that whoever concentrates on keeping his/her life whole and healthy by doing what he/she pleases and making personal satisfaction the focal point, will destroy and kill his/her chances of being in the Kingdom of God. But the one who goes beyond logic and gives his life to Jesus Christ will find meaningful existence on earth and will be with Him in Heaven.

In order to build and maintain a successful CCE program we must require fees for CCE. 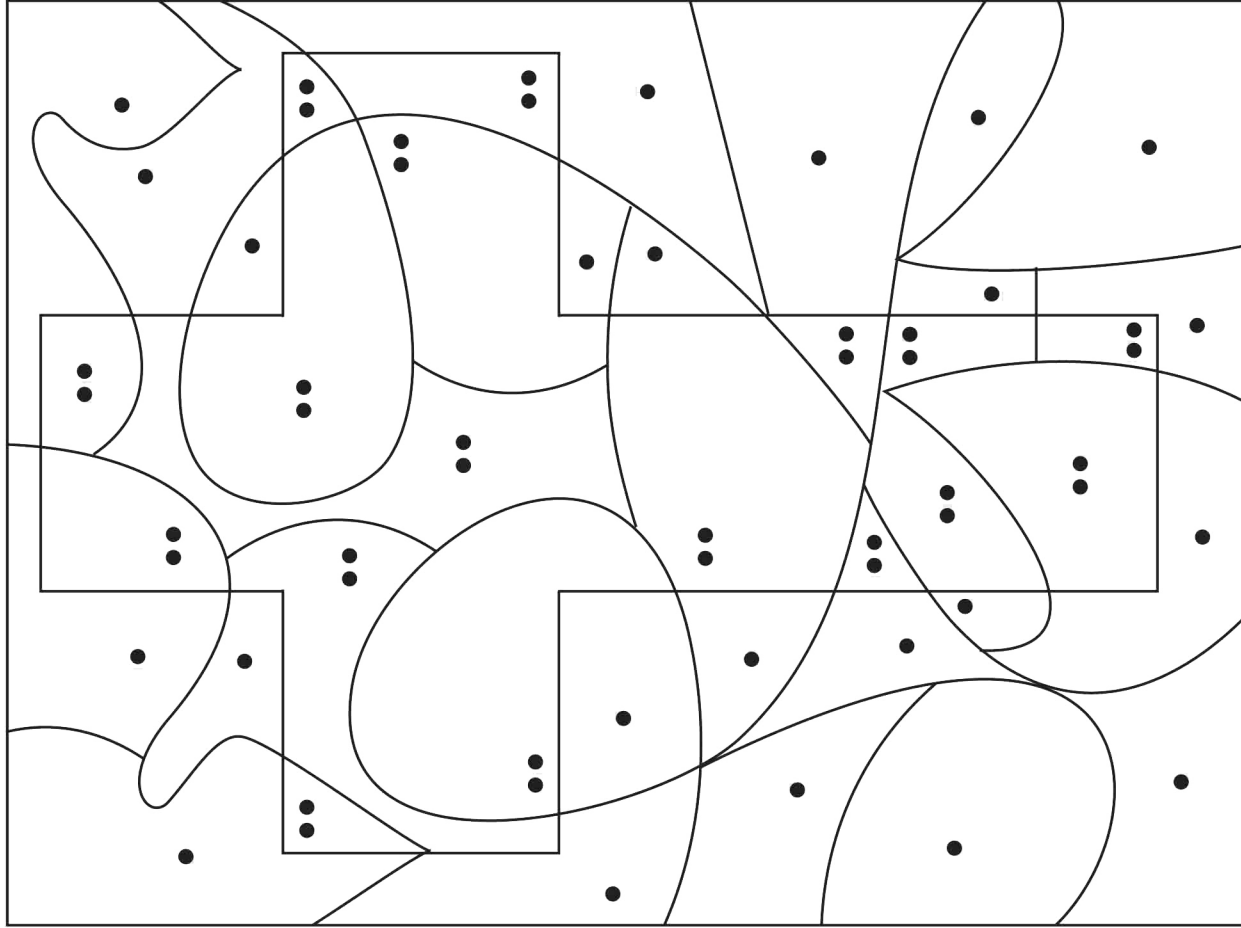

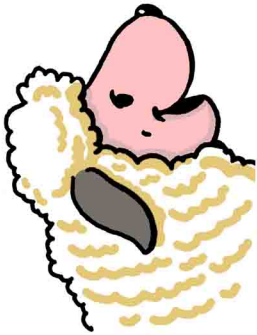

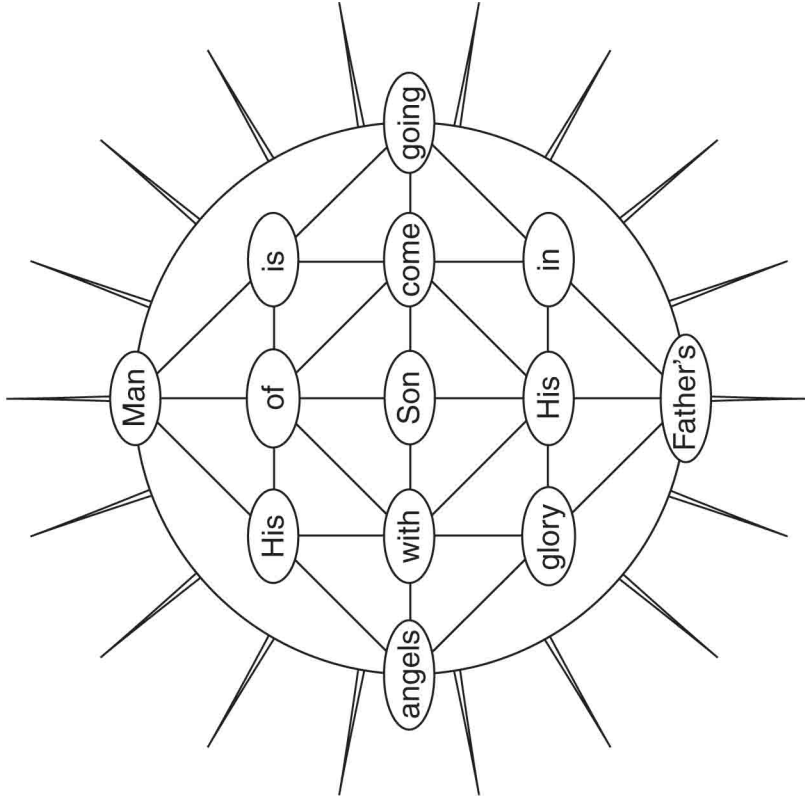
