Stewardship Reflection

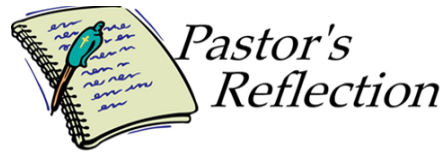

Holy Family: A Family with Faith and Legacy

I have been blessed to attend many a funeral service and have heard reflections and sermons about dead persons. What comes across all of them as very important is the message of legacy the dead person left behind. The testimonies are all about what the deceased person did while he/she was alive, what he/she wanted people to remember him for, who the descendants are and what contributions to society he/she has made.

My father died about 13 (thirteen) years ago at the age of 85. With children from different marriages, his greatest wish was having all of us acknowledge and support each other. After the funeral in the village, we all went to our various places of residence and continued with our lives. Then something interesting started to happen, we started getting in touch more often and shared family stories in honor of our father amid our grief. We started sharing (the good, the bad and the ugly) stories of the family which continues to bind us together. Our sharing has evolved into assisting one another, especially those in need, and motivating others to remember the generosity of our father and people like him.

Today we celebrate the Holy Family of Joseph, Mary, and Jesus. We also hear about the story of the beginning of Abraham's family. The selected scripture readings are all about family, heightened by promise, faith, and legacy. The writers of the stories of Abram, Sara, Joseph, Mary, and Jesus used devices not designed to be taken literally but contextually. This is because, if we act as though these annunciation stories took place exactly as recorded, we put these families into totally unique categories so different from us that there is no way we can identify with them.

In a heart-to-heart talk with God, Abram expressed his concern to God about Sarah being childless. God, not only quelled Abraham's anxiety, but also promised him land and a son whose descendants would be numerous. Sarah heard and laughed at the statement pronounced to her husband. Abraham responded to God's promise with trust and belief. This action was accredited to Abraham as an act of righteousness. A year later Sara and Abraham had a son. They named him Isaac. Isaac became second patriarch. Abraham and Sarah did not only have an heir, but also a future legacy, somebody who will tell their story to the next generation.

The Letter to the Hebrews prefaces Joseph's family story with Abraham's response in trusting God. The author of the Letter talked about Abraham's call narrative, God's covenant with Abraham, and the birth of Isaac. Isaac's children became the fulfillment of the legacy promised to Abraham by God. Hebrews teaches us about the great theological virtue of faith. With the Abraham story, this Letter showcases the virtue of faith and trust, and the divine benevolence of God who is faithful to his promises.

In Jesus' family story, Joseph fulfills the custom dictated by the law given by Moses and takes Mary and Jesus to the Temple. There in the Temple they met Simeon. With faith in God and in his promise, Simeon was waiting to meet and embrace "the Christ of the Lord". There in the Temple, Joseph's family also encounters the devout Prophetess Anna. She and Simeon spoke of the child and his mission. The legacy of Joseph and Mary would be having a son who would bring hope and contradiction to a world waiting for salvation and liberation.

As we celebrate the family of Joseph, Mary, and Jesus we re-evaluate our own families and what legacy we would like to leave. The Holy Family was not a perfect family. What makes it holy is not that they did not have problems, but that they practiced the ordinary virtues of kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, forgiveness, and love. In a knot shell, loving God as much as we love our neighbor and ourselves. When we reflect on the Biblical writings about the family of Joseph, Mary, and Jesus, we read that problems began even before conception took place; they observed the laws of their Jewish faith and were obedient to God.

In celebrating the Holy Family, we are reminded that our families can also be holy despite all the challenges facing us. The holy family was not a family without problems and heart aches. They were always faithful to God and in their faithfulness rests their legacy.

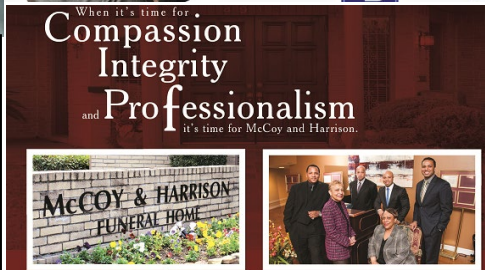
