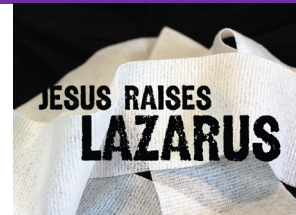

### AROUND THE ARCHDIOCESE

#### Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update March 17, 2020

These modifications are to be followed until further notice:

- The public celebration of all weekday and Sunday Masses will be suspended in the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston effective March 18, 2020. Churches are to remain open for individual and private prayer observing their normal hours, as discerned by the Pastors.
- Parishes, to the extent they are able, are to inform parishioners of the opportunity to view Masses either through network television or other live stream options over the internet.
- Sunday is still the Lord's Day. Families should gather to pray, read scripture, recite the Rosary, and reflect together on their faith
- The celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism is to be postponed, unless there is danger of death.
- Funerals may take place only in the form of "The Rite of Committal with Final Commendation" (also known as the "graveside"). A memorial Mass can be scheduled appropriately at a later date.

## Did you know that Catholics can make an Act of Spiritual Communion?

It has long been a Catholic understanding that when circumstances prevent one from receiving Holy Communion, it is possible to make an Act of Spiritual Communion which is a source of grace. Spiritual Communion means uniting one's self in prayer with Christ's sacrifice and worshiping Him in His Body and Blood.

The most common reason for making an Act of Spiritual Communion is when a person cannot attend Mass. Acts of Spiritual Communion increase our desire to receive sacramental Communion and help us avoid the sins that would make us unable to receive Holy Communion worthily. When unable to receive Holy Communion, pray the prayer below:

### A prayer for Spiritual Communion

**My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.**

**I love you above all things and I desire to receive you in my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive you sacramentally, Come at least spiritually into my heart.**

**I embrace you as if you were already there And unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from you. Amen.**

# Pastor's Reflection

**Standing at the empty tomb of Lazarus, we reflect on Jesus' question to Martha:  
"Did I not tell you that if you believe you will see the glory of God?" (Jn 11:40)**

In 600 BC Ezekiel was born in Babylon to a Jewish priestly family in exile. He was called to be a prophet of God to his people and nation. He began his prophecies with divine judgment and ended with consolation. Prophesying to humiliated and mournful exiles, he talked about his vision of a field covered with dry bones. This field of dry bones represented God's people and nation destroyed by the Babylonians. Torn away from the Promised Land they have come to live in the burial grounds of Babylon "dried and with no hope".

It was in the middle of this terrible valley of death that God promised to open up their graves of exile and bring them back to their own homes and land. God will join their bones together, cover them with flesh and breathe of life (Gen 2:7). From Ezekiel's vision, the people will rise (Ps.24:3) from their graves and worship the Lord in the Holy City. Having been freed from their entombment in exile, they will know that the God who had a covenant relationship with them is the one to be attentive to, obeyed and worshipped.

This vision of Ezekiel about God as the source of life prepares us for Jesus' raising his friend Lazarus from the dead. The Gospel reading from John's writings tells us about the last and greatest sign of Jesus. Note: In the Gospel of John, Jesus did not perform any miracle. He performed signs. These signs are not an end in themselves, rather they are indicators to greater things to come for all who love and believe in God. As indicators, they point into the past to include other signs that inform us about Jesus and why he was born and in the same way points into the future. The rising of Lazarus points to the resurrection of Jesus and our own future resurrection. Jesus has proclaimed He is "the resurrection and the life". He proved it by raising Lazarus. With this sign Jesus again teaches us that, like him, we will not be held in the clutches of death, but that when our earthly journey is over Jesus will bring us, we who follow him, home with him.

This Good News story of Lazarus and his two sisters began with his illness, then his death and climaxed with his being brought back to life. This story is filled with intense human emotions: fear, doubt, faith and hope all displayed. But not everyone who heard the story interpreted it positively.

As John shares with us Jesus enemies gathered to discredit and question his credibility. "What are we to do? This man is performing many signs. If we let him go on everyone will believe him". Even the high priest joined in to make Jesus the scapegoat when he said, "it is better for you to have one man die for the people than for the whole nation destroyed" (Jn 11:50).

With all that is going on in our world and especially in our country today, can we stand at "the empty tomb of Lazarus" and still feel the presence of God? As the Coronavirus is wrecking our society, making us live "in the burial grounds of Babylon dried and with no hope" do we still believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, the One who is to come to realize "the promise of God?" (Ezekiel 37:14). **Yes, I Believe! Do you?**
