



#### Saints - Those who Dared to Look Beyond

One of the most frustrating things in life is seeing your loved ones making the same mistakes that you made even as you do your best to warn them not to. This challenge is well noted especially in grandparent/grandchild relationships. With age and experience, grandparents can see the implications of things overlooked by parents as they raise their children. The thing about it is that parents and grandparents look at the same situation and see something quite different. The tension between grandparents and parents is what Fr. Karban, (November 2009 issue of the Celebration) calls the metaphor for faith. We all see the same thing but unlike those with no faith, people of faith see them differently and so they dare to look beyond.

Today we celebrate the solemnity of those who dared to look beyond. These, we call the saints. They pierced through to see the meaning and implications of what most of us do not see. Biblical scholars tell us that the earliest followers of Jesus did not have faith *in* Jesus, they rather shared the faith *of* Jesus. They were **Holy** not because they acted in a sanctimonious manner i.e. hands-folded and eyes looking heavenward, rather, they looked beyond and acted differently from the people around them.

To help us better reflect on our relationship with God and look beyond like the saints, the author of 1 John tells us, the Beloved, to "see what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called the children of God. Yet so we are." He shares with us the consequences of not believing in him. "The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him". The saints were able to look beyond and make themselves pure so that they could see God as He is. These are the ones we celebrate today.

The Book of Revelation gives us the hope needed to look beyond and even suffer persecution for the faith in the Risen Christ. Despite being persecuted for their faith, the saints were able to look beyond to see and hear the arrival of the angel holding the "seal of the living God". The seal signifies the events that will signal the "great trial". This "great trial", also known as the great persecution, will come before the Lamb's (Jesus) victory at the end of time when all the saints will gather with him.

The Book of Revelation tells us of four angels who had been instructed to wreak the final havoc. They were instructed not to do anything until the foreheads of "the servants of our God" have been sealed with the stamp that identifies them as God's property and protects them from the coming disaster. Those with the seal stamped on their forehead are those who looked beyond with faith and hope. They survived the "time of distress; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the lamb".

As we celebrate the solemnity of the Saints, we, the baptized, are reminded to look beyond and prioritize our activities like people destined for eternal life in the kingdom of heaven.

Jesus reveals to us how the wildly cheering multitudes standing before the Lamb live as God's family. These are God's sealed children who trusted in His son. They knew what the Son was talking about and became His disciples so that they could live with him forever.

Jesus demands that for one to be a saint, he/she must become perfect as God is perfect. This means that the behavior of the disciple should run counter to the "normal" human behavior. As disciples this is part of our mission on earth, i.e. to imitate God's holiness; to dare to go beyond as the saints did and listen to and act on Jesus words. The saints we celebrate today saw something deeper than what most people ever noticed in the teachings. They repented and experienced God working effectively in their lives.

Today as we celebrate the Saints, may our faith force us to turn things upside down so we can look at reality from a completely different perspective. Then we can use St. Paul's words in Philippians 3 as our own: "Whatever gains I had, these I have come to consider a loss because of Christ... For him I have accepted the loss of all things and I consider them so much rubbish". As we celebrate the solemnity of All Saints, can you and I look beyond so that we too can be counted among them?
