So You're Telling Me There's a Chance

Happy Sunday! Some of you may recognize this quote from a movie. The movie was made in 1994, which is 26 years ago. So what was the title of the movie? "Dumb and Dumber". For those of you who are not familiar with the movie, it is a comedy, starring Jim Carrey. The movie is

about two friends who are supposed to be dumb as they travel across the U.S. to return a client's briefcase.

The quote comes from a scene when a pretty woman tells Jim Carrey that he has a one-in-a-million chance of getting together with her. When she said this, he replied "so you're telling me there's a chance, Yeah!"

Today, brothers and sisters, we hear the Gospel reading about the two sons. God tells us that we have a chance.

The good news is that our chances are better than one-in-a-million when it comes to God's mercy and our sins.

God loves us unconditionally no matter what we do. We cannot earn that love. It is simply ours because this is the way God is. This is what we learned from Jesus in last week's Gospel. Today Jesus poses a question about two sons and asks which one did his Father's will. Then he tells the chief priests and elders, the righteous leaders of his day, "**Amen, I say to you, tax collectors and prostitutes are entering the kingdom of God before you.**" What a thing to say to righteous people, the people who faithfully said their prayers and followed all the Mosaic laws!

I think the underlying questions in our Gospel are: what is there about sinners that appealed so much to Jesus. Why did he seek sinners out, hang out with them, and feel comfortable around them? This raises the opposite question: why did Jesus feel uncomfortable with the righteous ones (i.e. the chief priests and the elders) and why did he get so frustrated with them? The Gospel tells us why. *It all has to do with conversion of heart, real change of heart.*

You see, the father said to the first son, "**Son, go out and work in the vineyard today,**" and he replied, "**I will not.**" Later he changed his mind and did what his father wanted. This reminds me of myself. For years God was calling me to be a Deacon and for years I was telling God no way, not me. I was thinking I was too busy with running the 'rat race'...raising a big family and working a demanding job. One day, however, through prayer and by the grace of God, I had a change of heart and said yes. I was like the first son who first said no and later changed his mind and went into the vineyard. The father asked the same of his second son. He replied, "**Yes, sir.**" But he never did it. He did not think he needed to. With which son do we identify? I hope the first.

It was the tax collectors and the prostitutes who said **no** to God when God called them to something better. But later they experienced a change of heart and mind. The chief priests and elders were like the second son. They said **yes** to God's call but did not follow through that call because they saw no need to. They were doing quite well. They saw no need to change. So, Jesus said to them, "**When John came to you in the way of righteousness, you did not believe him; but tax collectors and prostitutes did. Yet even when you saw that you did not later change your minds and believe him.**" Jesus loved sinners because sinners knew they needed to change. They knew they desperately needed God and opened their hearts to God's grace. Their hearts were softened.

The righteous people thought they had their lives in good order and settled for that. They were closed to God because they did not see any great need to change. Their hearts were set. With which son do **you** identify? Again, I hope the first.

Brothers and sisters, haven't we said **no** to God many times and gone our own way? But then we recognized our sin and repented and started over again.

Although we hope to always say **yes** to the Father and be faithful to our promises, at times we stumble.

Jesus says to us, I don't care what you have done. I don't care how low you have been. I don't care how often you have said no to our Father. *All that matters to me is that you acknowledge your sin, repent of your sin, and turn back to me.* Now I can work in you. You are one of the soft-hearted.

So You're Telling Me There's a Chance

How can we refuse such graciousness? How could we settle for things the way they are? How can we stay set in our ways when we are being invited to so much more?
