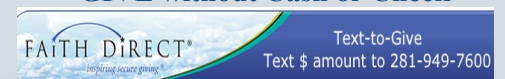

A Light to the Nations

Every Epiphany we hear the endless extent of God's goodness. Isaiah tells of the light shining forth from Jerusalem attracting peoples from near and far, from land and sea. The psalmist sings of eternal justice and peace leading all nations to adore the Lord. Paul teaches the Ephesians that they, and all Gentiles are members of the same body of Christ. Matthew writes of the magi from afar being drawn to the newborn king by the light from above. Let us look for that revelatory light that draws us more fully to the Lord.

(Cycle B)
January 3, 2021

"Where is the newborn King of the Jews?"
Matthew 2:1

What to do after Christmas?

The gifts have all been unwrapped. The trash cans are full of torn Christmas paper. Family and friends who came over for the holidays are headed home. The Christmas tree is now ready to come down. Nativity scenes are going back into storage. **That reminds me of a story.** It was after Christmas and a family was driving past a church. Their younger son was in the car and he noticed the church had taken down its outdoor nativity scene of Christ's birth. Innocently, the little fellow said from the backseat to his parents, **"look they have put away Jesus for another year!"** Unfortunately, that is what some people do. They put away Jesus (from their minds and hearts), along with the Christmas lights and decoration.

On the feast of the **Epiphany** (Jesus' physical manifestation to the Gentiles), we can learn something from the wise men-the Magi. These men were astrologers and they are mentioned in Matthew 2:1-12. The Gospel writer documents their search for Jesus. Interestingly, they discovered Jesus in a house (not a stable) in Bethlehem (Matthew 2:11). These wise men did **two things** after the birth of Christ, that you and I need to be doing **all year long**.

1. We ought to be seeking Christ all year long. These wise men were on a mission. They were seeking the King of the Jews. They were seeking Christ, long after the miracle of His birth. You can tell they were wise men, by who they were seeking. They were not seeking entertainment. They were not seeking pleasure. They were not seeking a good time. They were seeking the Son of God!

When we genuinely seek Christ, it requires some **effort on our part**. These wise men had traveled a great distance to find Christ. Seeking Christ is to **draw near to Him**, and (in return) He has promised to **draw near to us** (James 4:8).

The wise men had to overcome some obstacles. They had to deal with a *troubled*



King (Herod) and *all [of] Jerusalem* (Matthew 2:3). It's the same way with us. When going after Christ we will have to deal with people getting in the way. **Here is an example.** Someone is trying to lead you somewhere and they say, "follow me in my car." As you are following them in your car, you slack up and now other cars have gotten in between you and the one you are following. You have to get around some folk so you can get closer to the one who's trying to get you to your destination. **Do not let anyone come between you and your pursuit of Christ.** It is only through Christ that we can reach the Father (John 14:6).

2. We are to worship Christ daily. When the Magi found the child (with Mary His mother), *they prostrated themselves and did Him homage* (Matthew 2:11). The Amplified translation says, *"they fell down and worshipped Him."* One of the highest priorities of the Believer is to worship God. We are to worship Him because He is worthy. **Prostrate** is to cast (oneself) face down on the ground in adoration, humility, and submission. Hold nothing back; surrender all to Jesus, including yourself. Tell Him daily, **"Lord I surrender myself to You."**

Let us pray: Dear Christ, I promise to seek and worship You daily in this new year. Reveal Yourself to me as I strive through Scripture reading and prayer to move closer to You. In the name of Jesus, I pray. Amen.
