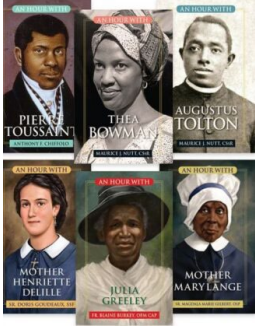

FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (C)

July 3, 2022

[Jesus said] "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few."

Luke 10:2

Things to remember, when harvesting (as a laborer) for Christ

Today's Gospel reading is recorded in Luke 10:1-12, 17-20. Jesus sent out seventy-two followers ahead of Him to locations where He planned to visit. Based on Luke's account, what can we modern-day disciples learn from this ancient commissioning?

1. Point people to Christ. (V. 9) *"Say to them, the kingdom of God is at hand for you."* Our purpose for following Christ is to make Him known to people all around us. **Less than a week ago** I was at a cemetery officiating the Rite of Committal for a dear friend and parishioner who had suddenly died from heart complications. Immediately after the Rite, a young man in the crowd asked to speak with me. He told me about **12 years ago** he discovered that he was to be furloughed (laid off) from his job with the City of Houston (COH). As he was getting off work one day, he saw and came to talk with me. I also worked for the COH but I was not in any danger of being furloughed. He said I gave him a name of a person to call to see if he could change from one department to another so he could continue working. He told me at the cemetery that he **contacted** that person and was eventually transferred and continued to work for the COH. He never was able to find and thank me for referring him to that person, until he saw me at the cemetery. (He was related to the parishioner who had died.) In the same way, we are to point people to Christ. It is up to them to make the contact and follow up. When you see someone in difficulty can you tell them, "I know **Someone** that can work this out for you?" Can you introduce them to Jesus the Christ?

2. Simply move on, if rejected. Vs.10-11. Some will be ready for conversion, while others will resist. **In last week's Gospel** (13th Sunday in Ordinary Time) Jesus specifically told His disciples not to **retaliate**. The Samaritan village

that Jesus was visiting **refused** to welcome Him. Jesus **rebuked** James and John when they asked to call down fire from heaven to destroy those Samaritans (Luke 9:55). Today in Verse 16, Jesus said, *"He who hears you hears Me, he who rejects you rejects Me, and he who rejects Me rejects Him who sent Me."* Even if you are rejected, **don't take it personally**, because the person is ultimately rejecting, **Jesus and the Father**. He instructed the disciples to **move on** if they were rejected, and to **offer peace wherever they went** (V. 5).

3. Stay humble. (V. 2) *"The harvest is abundant..."* Jesus is telling us that the harvest is plentiful and ready to be picked, but do you know **when wheat is ready for harvesting?** How do **you know** if you are ready to work as a laborer for Christ in His fields? When the wheat is **straight up** it's **not** ready for harvesting. It's



too green on the inside. When the wheat is **bent toward the ground**, that's when it's ready to be picked. For us to work in the fields **as laborers for Christ**, we have to be ready to be **harvested ourselves!** Some of us may not be ready for picking, because we are **conceited, arrogant, and proud**. This will keep us from being laborers in the field for Christ and will keep our **names** from being written in Heaven (Ref. V. 20).
