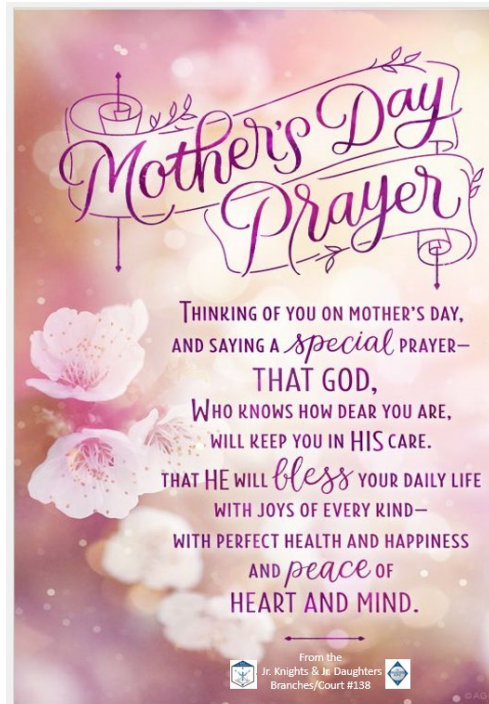

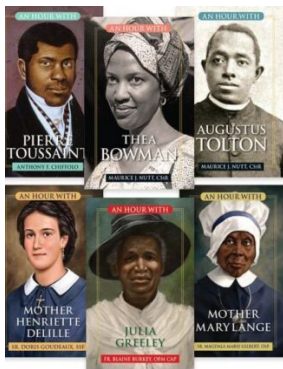

FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER (C)

May 8, 2022

*Jesus said, "My sheep hear My voice; I know them, and they follow me."
John 10:27*

God speaks to us in several different ways; please learn to listen!

Today's Gospel reading is a continuation of **John 10** where Jesus calls **Himself the Good Shepherd**. The focal point of these four verses (John 10:27- 30) is the relationship between the Shepherd and His sheep. If the sheep (followers of Christ) hears His voice, what are some of the ways that God communicates? I will list **five**.

1. The Lord speaks to us through His Word (Scripture, the Bible). Jesus quoted Deuteronomy 8:3 when He spoke to the devil and said, *"It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word of God'"* Luke 4:4. God's Word communicates to us instructions and guidance.

2. God speaks to us through people. That's why we have ministers in the church. Ephesians 4:11 says: *"And He Himself [the Lord] gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ."*

3. God communicates to us through nature. Jesus taught His disciples not to worry by using nature. *"So why do you worry about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin. Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will He not much more clothe you, O you of little faith?"* Matthew 6:28-31.

4. God may use situations or circumstances to warn us, that we are headed in the wrong direction. It may be a horrific car accident that you **narrowly escaped** or a health scare **that you survived**. God is trying to get our attention, and He will use anything to do so. In Jonah 1:17, God used an **unusual circumstance** to switch the direction of a prophet who had gone astray. A huge fish swallowed Jonah so the prophet could

change and do God's will. When God uses a frightful situation in your life, please **stop and say, speak Lord for Your servant is listening!**



5. God communicates with us through the Holy Spirit. Jesus said in John 14:26, *"The Holy Spirit...will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you."* Let me illustrate how this works. My Mom was bedridden during the last year of her life. She would call me to her room, but sometimes I wouldn't hear her. I got a **baby monitor** to solve the problem. I placed the **monitor** beside her bed, and I carried the **transmitter** with me. When she would call me, I would push the transmitter button and talk to her. It worked fine, as long as I focused on the transmitter. If I turned the transmitter volume down or started to cut the grass and couldn't hear the transmitter, then I couldn't respond when she called. The Holy Spirit speaks to our heart (the transmitter), and it's up to us to tune out the distractions of life and listen so we can hear the Holy Spirit.

Even though Mom has died, I still have her baby monitoring system. It commemorates the special bond and love we had for each, but it also reminds me to always be alert for when the Holy Spirit speaks. **Mom, continue to rest well!**
