
### GOD IS THE STRENGTH OF MY HEART

That we go beyond the minimum required and give generously in proportion to what God has given each of us. "You, son of man, I have appointed watchman for the house of Israel..." - Ezekiel 33:7 Many of us are generous with our gifts. However, many of us are not generous in proportion to the gifts we have been given. How often do we give at the minimum level required? Remember, the Lord calls us to nurture and develop our gifts and to give back with increase. He calls us to be generous with all the gifts, especially the one that means the most to us.

TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A) September 10, 2023

"For where two or three are gathered together in My name, there am I in the midst of them." Matthew 18:20

We are to help each other; stay on the right track! All three readings address how believers are to assist each other as we walk with Christ. Here they are:

1. The Importance of Relationship. As followers of Christ, we must be connected. Preceding today's Gospel passage, Jesus tells His disciples the parable of the lost sheep (Matt. 18:10-14). The caring Shepherd left the ninety-nine to seek out the one who had gone astray. The ninety- nine were fine; it was the lone sheep who was in danger of being destroyed. There was a man who lived across the street from his church but hadn't been in a while. One Sunday, after services ended, the Pastor saw the man barbecuing outside and went over. "Hey brother, we have been missing you", said the Pastor. "We would love to see you back in God's House." The man said, "Well, I don't have to go to church every Sunday, do I Reverend?" "I am the church, right?", said the man. "Why do I have to be in church", asked the man. The Pastor said, "Can I see that pair of cooking thongs?" The man said, "Yeah, here you go." The Pastor took one of the coals that was so hot it was an orange color. He threw the coal on the concrete, and just watched it. The man looked at it too. The coal went from orange to gray, to a white ashy color; then it went out. The Pastor looked at the brother and said, "That's why you need to be in the church." For that coal to burn, and stay lit, it has to be touching other coals. For Christians to stay on fire for God, we have got to be touching. You can't let your fire go out. We have to stay with the other coals because in today's Gospel, Jesus promised that, "where two or three are gathered together in My name, there am I in the midst of them" (Matthew 18:20). We are not to forsake ourselves from assembling (Cf. Heb.12:5).

# **2.** The Importance of Loving each other. In the second reading St. Paul tells the Roman Church,

"Owe nothing to anyone, except to love one another" Rom. 13:8. He also says, "Love does no evil to the neighbor; hence, love is the fulfillment of *the law*" (Rom. 13:10). Jesus said, "*By this, all men will know you are My disciples if you have love for one another*" (John 13:35). Love is the Christians' identity card.

Everyone has a love tank. As Christians, we help fill each other's love tanks by using words of affirmation to build each other up (Cf. Eph. 4:29). Stay away from toxic people, those who want to kill, steal, and covet what you have (Cf. Rom. 13:9).

**3. The Importance of Being God's Speaker. In the First Reading,** God tells the prophet Ezekiel, "[*If*] you do not speak out to dissuade the wicked from his way...I will hold you responsible for his death" (Ezekiel 33:8). We are to be God's speaker to warn those who are going the wrong way. Notice **God has the microphone.** "When you hear Me say anything, you shall warn [Israel] for Me" (Ezekiel 33:7). **The only job of the speaker** 

# is to project the words of the One who has the microphone.

If you had a cure for cancer, why would you keep that hidden, and thousands of people are dying from cancer? Why not share it? **We know the cure for sin**. What can wash away my sin; **Nothing but the blood of Jesus.** Who do you know is dying in their sins, and you haven't spoken to them about Christ and repentance? **Why would you keep that to yourself**?


