**The Last Supper**

The Palm Sunday liturgy always focuses on the Passion, but we begin with a short reading from Isaiah, who prophesied of a person who suffered terribly for faithfully speaking God’s word. Sound familiar? Indeed, Saint Paul testifies that Jesus “humbled himself... to the point of death.” Let today’s scripture passages remind us of the physical and emotional suffering that our Lord endured in order to truly proclaim God’s word.

**Did you know that Catholics can make an Act of Spiritual Communion?**

When unable to receive Holy Communion, pray the prayer below:

**A Prayer for Spiritual Communion**  
**My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love you above all things and I desire to receive you in my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive you sacramentally, Come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace you as if you were already there and unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from you. Amen**

*Stewardship Reflection*

That we have the strength and courage to stand up for those in need of our help. “Pilate again said to them, ‘Then what shall I do with the man whom you call the King of the Jews?’ And they cried out again, ‘Crucify him.’” – Mark 15:12-13 Jesus told us “whatever you do for the least of my brothers, you do for me.” Every day we are presented opportunities to help someone. ## PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD <sup>(B)</sup> March 24, 2024

This Sunday we celebrate Palm Sunday. In the days following Palm Sunday, we journey with Jesus during his final days here on earth. We remember his passion, death, and resurrection. We will rise with him in the Paschal Feast

During these weeks we have been preparing with those who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil. This is an opportunity for all of us who are baptized in Christ to renew our commitment to him. At the heart of our faith is God's commitment to us in sending his only son to die for us. God's passion is that we will be one with Him. Jesus enters into our history to show us what it really means to be human. In essence, he shows us that sometimes we will be praised by the crowd and at the moment he needed them the most, they will shout- crucify him!

The Gospel tells us that Jesus enters triumphantly into Jerusalem riding on a borrowed donkey. Jesus was greeted by the crowds as they praised God and shouted "Hosanna!" All four Gospels record this event. This year we read the passion from Luke's Gospel. In the reading of the Passion, we hear the details of several events: Jesus' Last Supper, his prayer in the garden of Gethsemane, Judas's betrayal, the arrest of Jesus, Peter's denial of Jesus, and how Jesus was accused and sentenced to death. Through Jesus' death, we have been set free for holiness and life. Let's prayerfully listen to the reading of this Gospel. When Jesus died on the cross, he felt abandoned and alone, and he cried out to God. In his death, Jesus identified with all those who feel alone and abandoned in our world.

As a Church and as individual Christians here at St. Francis Xavier, we are called to look for ways to reach out to all those who feel alone, to share with them God's love and care. In the Gospel passage that we read today. Jesus' disciples do not show themselves as models of faith. As we look at their actions, we wonder if they can really continue Jesus' ministry after his death. Like the disciples, we too question our aptitude to do ministry like Jesus, with compassion and respect for others. Jesus knowing that he would be leaving us a legacy of faith and the Holy Spirit will guide us.

On Holy Thursday, we end our Lenten observance, and we will celebrate Jesus at the Last Supper, the disciples all said that they would not betray Jesus. Jesus performs the ultimate act of humility as he washes their feet to express his love. He then comforted them even though their faith was to be shaken. Peter protested and said, "Lord, I will never betray you." Peter denied Jesus, and the disciples were not present during Jesus' passion and death. Only the women who had been followers of Jesus in Galilee are said to have been present at the Crucifixion, but they remained at a distance. In spite of this, Jesus still loves us and says we will be with him in God's kingdom.

During this Holy Week, let us reflect on how strong is our faith in Jesus when we see him suffering under the weight of the Cross? Are we still willing to stand by him even when it seems impossible for him to get out of this situation? Have we forgotten all the times we saw miracles happen and how God removed us from situations that could cause us harm? Will you be there when they crucify my Lord? Are you willing to be there when they nail him to the Cross? Will you be there when they put him in the thumb. Oh yes! Sometimes it causes us to tremble, tremble, tremble. When we contemplate on our journey of faith. But, oh what a great comfort to know that we are there when that roll away the stone. And the Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, always have mercy on us.

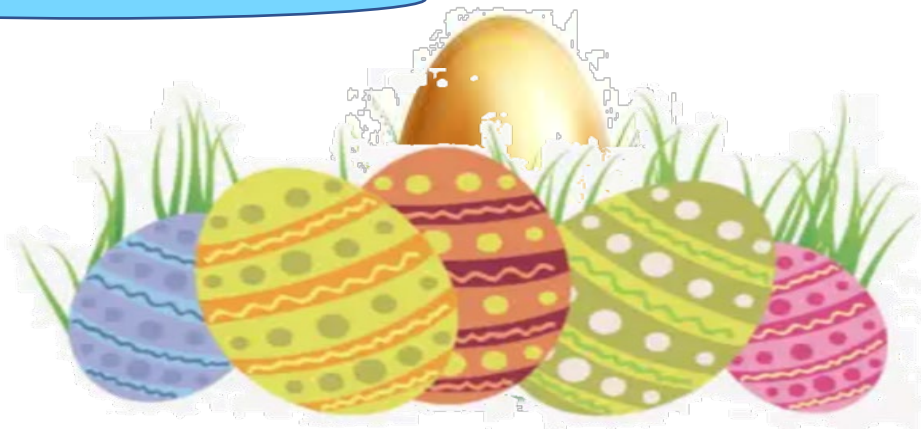

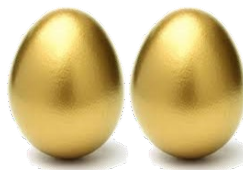

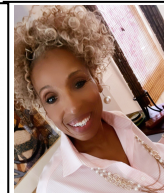
