SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT (A)

This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to Him." Matt. 17:5

Make being right with God the number one priority for your soul!

From the **First Reading** and the **Gospel**, remember these practical lessons for our **Lenten journey**.

The Lord said to Abram: "Go forth from the land of your kinsfolk and from your father's house to a land that I will show you" Genesis 12:1.

1. God may call you out of-or away from-people, places or situations so He can effectively use you. God told Abram (later named Abraham) to leave his country, kindred, and father's house.

The Lord wanted to separate him from the idolatry of the land, to test his faith and to establish a new nation and way of life. The disciples forsook all and followed Jesus (cf. Luke 5:11). We must understand that our Heavenly Father has a better plan for our lives than we do for ourselves. "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord. Plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future" (Jeremiah 29:11).

After being delivered from Egypt, the Israelites, led by Moses, camped at Mount Horeb (Sinai). After a time, the Lord commanded Moses to tell the people that they had **circled the mountain long enough** and that they must **move forward** to the Promised Land (Deuteronomy 2:2-3). God had something better for them. What is God calling you out of? What is God calling you from? What does God want you to separate from? What does He want you to put distance between? It may be separation from getting angry so quickly, getting even with people, and instead heading toward the land of forgiveness. You may be circling a mountain of regret-where someone wronged you, a job let you go, or a spouse left you. God may be telling you to separate from that and move forward. **Why?** So He can bless you, and in turn, you can bless others. That is what God did for Abram-the Lord blessed him so others could be blessed (Genesis 12:2-4). God blesses you to be a blessing to others.

2. Like the Son, our obedience pleases God.

In the Gospel reading (Matthew 17:1-9) we see the account of Jesus' Transfiguration. During this vision, a voice was heard from the cloud that had formed: "**This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to Him.**" Why is Our Heavenly Father pleased with His Son? **The**

Son was obedient to the Father. Jesus said, "**I came down from heaven not to do My own will but the will of the One who sent Me**" (John 6:38).

Are you **obedient** to the will of God in your life? Recently, I saw a dear friend of mine-who is diabetic-walking **again** in a **medical shoe** on his right foot. He said, "As you can see my foot is **back** in the boot. **Disobedience, is the reason why.** I can't be **mad** at anybody but myself. The doctor told me what to do, but the sore on my foot started opening up again because I didn't follow instructions." "When I finally went back to the doctor, I was scared, **because I knew I wasn't doing right**, and they had already been talking about amputating my big toe. The doctor was kind, but he said, 'You are back to square one.'" Did my friend's **disobedience** hurt the doctor or himself? He hurt himself. When we are disobedient to God, we are hurting ourselves-not God. We will all stand before God and give an account of ourselves to the Lord (Romans 14:12). Many of us are terrified of the **Judgment** because we have been **disobedient**. My friend's walk had changed because of the medical boot. The Lord helped me to understand that our walk with Him also changes because of **disobedience**.

Disobedience costs us dearly. It hinders our progress, our blessing, and our relationship with God. My friend could have been blessed to have that wound healed and to walk in regular shoes, but he was **disobedient**. Blessings follow **obedience**. In this **Lenten season, make being right with God the number one priority for your soul**. Jesus asked this question: "**Why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do the things which I say?**" Luke 6:46 <> Dcn. Jenkins
