



## Stewardship Reflection

That we show mercy to someone we need to reconcile with. "Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.'" (John 20:21) Peace – the first gift of the risen Lord. Just as Jesus sent the apostles out into the world, so too, He sends us. As disciples of Jesus, we are called to be compassionate and merciful; and not with just those who are our friends, but also with our "enemies." Think of someone in your life who you need to reconcile with. Call them right now or better yet, go visit them.

## THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY




Our Lord gave St. Faustina a set of prayers to invoke His mercy, called the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. On standard rosary beads, pray the following prayers:

First, on the Crucifix:  
One Our Father, Hail

Mary and the Apostles' Creed.

On each Our Father bead pray: ***"Eternal Father, I offer You the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins, and those of the whole world."***

On each Hail Mary bead pray: ***"For the sake of His sorrowful passion, have mercy on us, and on the whole world."*** Repeat for five decades. To conclude, pray three times: ***"Holy God, holy mighty One, holy immortal One, have mercy on us, and on the whole world."***

### Jesus Will Meet Us Wherever We Are

Happy Sunday! Christ is Risen! Alleluia!

Today's Gospel reminds us: **Jesus will meet us wherever we are.** He accepts our fears, doubts, and struggles.

The disciples had locked themselves away in fear after Jesus' crucifixion. Yet even behind closed doors, Jesus came into their midst. He met them

where they were...terrified, defeated, broken.

Sometimes, when life gets hard, we do the same. We lock our doors, retreat into our own "caves." Maybe we isolate ourselves. Maybe we try to handle it all alone.

I'm reminded of a book from years ago, *Men Are from Mars, Women Are from Venus*. It said that when **men** face stress, they often withdraw into their "caves" to sort things out. **Women**, on the other hand, usually want to talk things through.

Either way, the Good News is this: Jesus meets us right there. In our cave, in our struggle, in our doubt. He comes with mercy. He comes with peace.

Jesus meets us:

- In our fear and anxiety.
- In our brokenness and grief.
- In our uncertainty and weakened faith.

Jesus met Thomas exactly where he was, too. Thomas needed to see and touch to believe...and Jesus let him. He gave Thomas what he needed.

Jesus does the same for us. He gives us the Eucharist, the bread and wine that become His Body and Blood, something we can touch and taste, to remind us that He is real and risen.

And Jesus says: **"Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe."** That's you. That's me.

When He appears to the disciples, He doesn't scold them for running away. He says, **"Peace be with you."** He forgives. He loves. He sends them out to be His witnesses: **"As the Father has sent me, so I send you. Receive the Holy Spirit."**

Today, on this Divine Mercy Sunday, Jesus says the same to us:

- If you are afraid... **"Peace be with you."**
- If you feel you've let God down... **"Peace be with you."**
- If you feel inadequate... **"Receive the Holy Spirit."**
- If you long to know Jesus is real... **"Come, touch and receive."**

Wherever you are today, whatever you are going through, **Jesus will meet you there.**

Let us receive Him with love and gladness...and let us go out to love and serve others.
