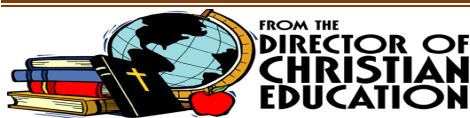


Two weeks before we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles at

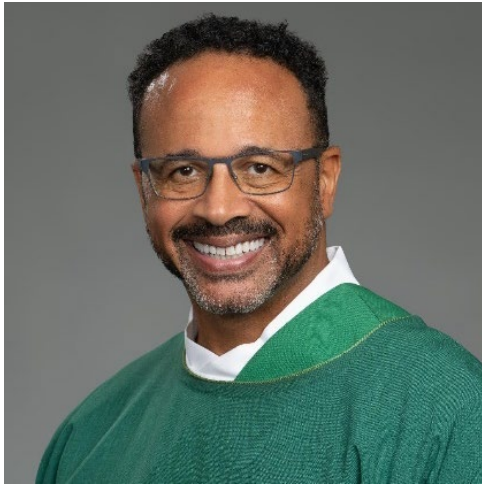

A Mother's Love Reflects the Very Love of God

Happy Sunday and Happy Mother's Day! This Sixth Sunday of Easter beautifully coincides with Mother's Day, giving us an opportunity to reflect on how the love of a mother often mirrors the very love of God.

In today's Gospel, Jesus says: **"I will not leave you orphans..."** (John 14:18)

Those words are deeply comforting. Jesus reminds His disciples, and us, that we are never abandoned. Even as He prepares for His Passion, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension, He promises the gift of the Holy Spirit and assures them of His constant presence.

That promise sounds familiar because many of us have experienced it first through our mothers.

A mother's love is often the first reflection of God's love we encounter. It is a love that stays. A love that sacrifices. A love that forms, corrects, and sustains.

Mothers love with a love that nurtures the soul.

They teach us right from wrong.

They pray for us when we forget how to pray for ourselves.

They correct us not to punish us, but to shape us.

They protect us, encourage us, and often carry burdens we never fully see.

That kind of love is holy.

Jesus says, **"If you love me, you will keep my commandments."**

Love is not merely emotion, it is formation. Real love calls us higher. It challenges us to grow. It helps us become who God created us to be.

Many of us know that truth firsthand. Sometimes Mama's love looked like comfort. Sometimes it looked like correction. Sometimes it was simply "the look" across church that instantly reminded us to act right!

That was love, too.

Because both mothers and Jesus love with a love that refuses to leave us where we are.

On this Mother's Day, we honor not only biological mothers, but also grandmothers, godmothers, stepmothers, adoptive mothers, aunts, mentors, teachers, and all women who have offered maternal love and spiritual guidance.

We also remember those for whom this day is difficult; those grieving mothers they have lost, mothers carrying hidden pain, women longing to be mothers, and those navigating complicated family relationships.

God sees every heart.

And for those still praying for children who have wandered...take heart. Remember Saint Monica, who prayed faithfully for years for her son Augustine before his conversion. Her perseverance reminds us that a praying mother's love is powerful.

Today is a good day to say thank you.

Thank you for the sacrifices.

Thank you for the prayers.

Thank you for staying.

And above all, thank you, Lord, for reminding us that we are never alone.

We are not orphans.

We are deeply loved, eternally accompanied, and forever held in the love of God.

And often, we first learned that through the love of a mother.

Because truly: **A Mother's Love Reflects the Very Love of God.** Amen

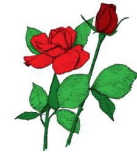

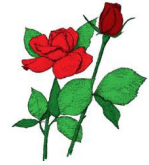

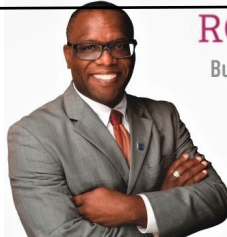
