Dan worked with the county road commission on a comprehensive preservation road plan. For the next 2 years the sealing of roads will occur. This will be followed by a total reconstruction for the remainder of Cottonwood Ave.

- Reseal Elm Ave. from 8 Mile Rd. north to dead end \$11,352.00
- Reseal 7 Mile Rd. west of Elm Ave. to end of pavement \$18,264.00
- Reseal Cypress Ave. from 9 Mile Rd. north to cemetery \$18,480.00
- Reseal 8 Mile Rd. from Elm Ave. to Hickory and Hickory north to end of pavement \$40,944.00
