History

Recognizing that many in her community faced similar struggles, she created programs focused on housing stability, food security, workforce development, and financial literacy to support long-term sustainability.

SERVICES

-  **Housing Stability Assistance** – Support for families facing eviction, payment assistance, tenant rights education, and mediation between tenants and landlords.
-  **Food Pantry & Nutrition Support** – Weekly food distribution, grocery gift cards, and resources to combat food insecurity.
-  **Workforce Development** – Access to computers, resume building, job application assistance, and job leads.
-  **Financial Literacy Education** – Workshops & classes on savings/ budgeting, credit building, and money management for long-term financial stability.
-  **Digital Literacy** – Technology workshops for older adults.
-  **Youth** – Real-world skills in entrepreneurship, community service, and math through our program.
