Sister City Commission

Montgomery, as Alabama's capital city, one of its largest metro areas, and home of the Maxwell Air Force Base, has a large international draw. In the past it has developed a Sister City relationship with Pietrasanta Italy, but we feel that a city of our stature should grow the number of formal connections with other cities across the world. When looking at cities of similar size across the nation, the majority tend to have more than one, and our two closest major cities, Mobile and Birmingham both have closer to 15 each. We don't advocate for that many, as we feel a narrower focus on developing a few strong, active connections is better than just having a long list of barely active connections.
