- DAY ONE: TRAVEL FROM ORIGIN TO SENEGAL WEST AFRICA
 - · DAY TWO: ARRIVE IN SENEGAL
- DAY THREE: HISTORY, CULTURE AND CITY TOUR TOUR AROUND THE CITY, LEARNING THE HISTORY OF SENEGAL THROUGH VISITING SEVERAL HISTORICAL SITES (E.G. N'GOR ISLAND, MUSEUM OF BLACK CIVILIZATION, AFRICAN RENAISSANCE MONUMENT AND MORE).
- Day four: Goree Island The Day of History Begins with a 20 minute Ferry Ride From Dakar to one of Senegal's top destinations and the Most Visited Sites in Senegal, Goree Island. Participants will visit the "The Door of No Return" which is a major departure point in the African Slave Trade and is the Last Place African Slaves saw before being Shipped Across the Ocean to the Americas.
