Brownsville Ambulance Cadet Program

Overview

The Brownsville Ambulance Cadet Program is a five-day summer program designed to provide immersive experience for young adults aged 14-17 who are interested in emergency medicine, the healthcare field, or who wish to gain firsthand insight into what emergency medicine entails.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be between the ages of 14-17.
- Applicants must reside within the Brownsville, California, or East Beth school districts.
- A completed application form is required.
- Applicants must provide at least two reference letters from non-family members (e.g., teachers, school staff, volunteer organizations).
- Attendance for all five program days is mandatory.
- A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required.
- Only 24 students will be accepted into the program.

Program Schedule

- The program will take place from June 23rd to June 27th, from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
- A graduation ceremony and skills demonstration will be held on June 28th.

Application Process

- Applications will be accepted from March 1st through March 28th.
- Each applicant will receive a list of interview questions via email. Interviews will be conducted in the evenings from April 7th to April 18th at Brownsville Ambulance Service, located at 12 Arch Street, Brownsville, PA.
- Accepted applicants will receive a welcome packet via email, containing paperwork that must be signed and submitted prior to the start of the program.

Applications will be accepted from March 1*-28*. Interviews will be held in the evening during the weeks of April 7*-18*. Cadets and their families are responsible if selected to provide their own transportation to and from Brownsville Ambulance station during the week of June 23*-27*. If selected, cadets will receive a welcome package along with key learning objectives for the 5-day learning period. Sessions will be held from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Strict adherence to safety protocols, learning objectives, and attendance are required if accepted into the program. By signing you acknowledge this is an application only, and not an official notice of acceptance into the program. Eight applicants will be chosen from each of the three schools in the Brownsville Ambulance Service area. We look forward to this program and its future impact.
