Authoring the Ineffable: Translative Practices of Omnidimensional Authors

This session introduces a groundbreaking literary framework that redefines authorship through spiritual sovereignty, ineffable transmissions, and alternative ability. Drawing from lived practice and academic research, attendees will explore trance-based, divinatory, and spirit-led writing modes that challenge dominant narratives in publishing and pedagogy. - This session is designed for authors, scholars, spiritual practitioners, and creatives seeking to explore non-traditional, embodied, and spirit-led modes of authorship. THEORETICAL FRAMEWORK & RESEARCH CONTEXT

This suite arises from research in ineffable literary studies, and spiritual epistemologies, exploring how *Non-bodied*, and *Omnidimensional Authors* translate, and communicate in ways that challenge current literary and academic frameworks.

We draw on traditions (or "alternative abilities") such as *mediumship*, *trance writing*, *channeling*, *divinatory practices*, and *legal history* to propose new models of authorial recognition.

RESEARCH METHODS FOR INEFFABLE AUTHORSHIP



Qualitative Methods

- Interpretive Phenomenological Analysis (IPA): Captures lived experiences of OAs through reflective interviews and journaling.
- **Documentations:** Personal narrative, spirit-led insights, and trance states used as primary texts.
- Lineage & Textual Mapping: Comparative study of ineffable literary traditions across spiritual, ancestral, and heteronymic frameworks.
- Content Analysis: Coding and interpretation of symbolic language, divinatory texts, and non-linear narratives from session outputs.

Quantitative Methods

- Lexicon Analysis: Measuring recurrence of terms across multiple authors or sessions.
- Pattern Mapping: Documenting time, duration, and consistency of altered-state sessions.
- **Practitioner Data:** Collecting responses from authors using alternative abilities to identify collective trends.
- Multimodal Consistency Testing: Correlating insights with repeated results across formats.



Their secondary research delves into Omnidimensional Authors (OAs) and their literary practices. As the Academic Oracle behind the Cannabis Tarot®, they merge transdisciplinary research, indigenous & spiritual authorship to pioneer the ineffable, and alternative ability practices for the future of the literary arts.
