This Agreement made this 10th of January 1769

By & between Mathias Greene and Christopher Greene
on the one part and John Sawley & Michael Sawley
on the other part Shewing all of Mr. Rowland Minter's
that whereas there has formerly been a dispute
in the Line between our Lands, Greenes to the West
and Sawleys to the North of said Line and having
This day had this Line Run between us to our full
Satisfaction by Mr. Job Greene, who began at a Post
or Stake called so standing thereby in the Line
near the middle thereof next for from a Spring
in Mr. John Sawleys Land and then Westward
through and from thence Run westward to a Stake
called so marked on four sides which stands
said to be Greenes's fence and from thence came back
to the stake or Stake called so set off from and there-
upon the opposite Course to the Order marking
several Oak trees one marked to the westward of
the Stone that leads to sd. Sawleys House and there
was the other or that nearest the ~~Stone~~ River a little
to the South and came to a Stone heap by the side of a
which was the east end of the Line between us Westward & we
all agree upon it so to be; the Line came considerably to the
Westward of John Sawleys's Stake one which he agrees
to be so. The whole of the above we severally & jointly
agree to & Oblige ourselves our Heirs Assigns &
Said by; in perfecting the Term of sd. hundred
Dollars for any breach of the above Agreement to the
aggrieved Party or Parties & to satisfy and Conform to the
same we take Oaths to set our Hands
