To all Whose Righte to whom these presents shall come I shew cause

of the said John Lewellyn, the North-east corner being in the  
line between the said John Lewellyn & Thomas Witt  
And I do hereby say that the said John Lewellyn & his heirs &  
and from thence to the said John Lewellyn his heirs &  
and then to the said John Lewellyn his heirs &  
comes to the middle line that Thomas Wittward & South between  
the said John Lewellyn & Thomas Wittward's land.

To those and to hold the said premises & burgesses & burgesses
