Current money of New England to me in hand before the Sealing hereof, and subscribed by Peter Leucally of Warwick in the
County and Coloney above laid the ^{year} receipt whereof I Do hereby acknowledge and my self therewith fully Satisfid Contented and red
and thereof and of Every part and parcel thereof Do Exonerate quit and discharge the said Peter Leucally his heirs Executors
and Administrators for ever by these presents have given granted bargained sold aliened gave off Conveyed and confirmed
and by these presents do freely fully and absolutely give Grant bargain sell alien Enseppye Convey and Confirm unto him
the said Peter Leucally his Heirs and assigns for Ever a certain tract or piece of land situate lying and being
partly in Country and partly in Warwick and said land being with in the Open fields of Natick Containing fifty
acres no more nor no less and said Land out as near as may be butted and bounded as followeth to w^e
Southw^e on land of michel Leucally Esq^r by on land of thomas Utter Northw^e and westerly on land of the
Quaker to have and to hold the said Granted and bargained Premises with all the appurtenances precedent and

measure at deale obtain or make void this present Deed of Sale further more I the said Job Green
for my self my heire Executors and administrators do Covenant and Engage the above demised premises
to him the said Peter L[eu]calle his heires and assigns against the lawfull claims or demands of any person or persons
