do have and to hold the said Jamies Release and Quit Claimed premises, with their Appurtenances, unto him the said Peter Swalley, his heirs and Assignes forever, In Witness Whereof the said Marye Swalley have hereunto set my hand and seal at Warwick aforesaid the tenth fifth day of January in the Year of our S^{ds} M^{ts} our Monoured Queen Elizabeth and by this three 1783 —
