BE it hereby known, That **1** *Calcl Matheway* of **Providence Plantations,** *Providence* in the County of *Providence* and State of Rhode-Island and **5** *five Shillings* Pounds do grant, bargain, sell and transfer, unto *Shr. Hammarville* Committee's Office for the State aforesaid, a certain Tract of Land, situate in the Town of *Providence* and bounded *Southwley on land of Philip Greene Esq^r Northwley by Matheway upon land of Peter Sewell Esq^r Eastwley upon land of that I gave my three sons namely Peter and John Sewell by Robertham Quaker does be the same marker kept*

or however otherwise the same maybe reputed to be bounded, with all the Buildings and Appurtenances to the same belonging; to have and to hold unto the said *Shr Hammarville* and his Successor or Successors in said Office, forever, in trust, to and for the sole Use and Behoof of all the Citizens of said State, forever; and I the said *Calcl Matheway* do covenant to and with the said *Shr Hammarville* in his said Capacity: For myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, that I am lawfully seized of the Premises aforesaid in Fee-Simple, free from all Incumbrances. In Testimony whereof I hereunto set my Hand and Seal, the *Eighth* Day of *September* A. D. 1786.

THE Condition of the above Deed is such, That if the said *Calcl* cause to be paid unto the said *Shr Hammarville* his Heirs, Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, shall pay or or their Successors in said Office, the Interest and Principal of the Sum of *Twenty one* Pounds *five Shillings*, in Bills beforementioned, or in Silver and Gold equivalent according to the Tenor and Effect of Fourteen Bonds, entered into by the said *Calcl Matheway* to the said *Shr Hammarville* in their Capacities aforesaid, and bearing the same Date herewith, then the foregoing Deed shall be void, otherwise the same shall remain in full Force.
