and truly paid by Peter Sewall of the Town of Wrentham and state
of New England the Receipt Whereof I do hereby acknowledge
and am herewith fully satisfied & paid & have thereby
Released and for ever quit Claimed and by these presents do I
Release and for ever quit Claim unto Peter Sewall his heirs and
assignes for ever all my Right Title Interest Power and Demand
Whosoever of and unto all the Real and personal Estate of our Honor
Bartholomew Michael Sewall which descends unto me & this deep
Solemnly being & being in Warwick or elsewhere

To have and to hold the said Claimed and Quit
Claimed premises with their appurtenances unto him the
said Peter Sewall and to his heirs assignes forever In Witness
Whereof I the said Mary Sewall have hereunto set my hand
and seal at Warwick aforesaid the Twenty sixth day of September
In the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety
nine 1799
