I know all men by their parents that I Stephen Swalley of Townsile by the
County of Trent and State of Massachusetts, yeoman find in consideration of the
sum of four hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Colthorn Swalley of said
countymale single woman the weight whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have
received and former quit claimed and do by these presents warrant
release and forever quit claim unto her the said Colthorn Swalley her
heir and assigns forever, two certain lots of land one being called the house
lot and the other called wood lot marked on the Plot Number two
& drawn in right of Arthur Swalley as marked on the Plot will more
fully appear of the Division of the Estate of Peter Swalley deceased and
one bounded as follows the house lot is bounded northerly of Robert & Southside
on lot number one drawn in right of Margaret Hemmings & westerly
on the County and Greater Humphreys Road, together with the
house and other buildings thereon standing on the wood lot is bounded
as follows northerly on lot number three drawn in right of
Mary Swalley Robert on land Robert and Thomas Swalley South of the
one land of Son Arnold westerly on the Hampshire road, for a further
description of said lots reference is to be had to the Plot as above said
and I shiner Swalley wife of the above said Arthur Swalley for
the consideration paid to my husband as above said do relinquish
all my right of Power and Power of Heir, in the Premises as above
described to have and to hold the above described Premises together
with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging to her
the said Colthorn Swalley her heirs and assigns forever In witness
