in consideration of the sum of *One Hundred and Fifty Dollars to be
in hand well and truly paid by said Church or inc

convey unto the said *Orson Chapman* heirs
heirs and assigns forever, all our right, title, interest, property, claim and demand which
we now have, or of right ought to have or claim, in and to

*A certain lot of land lying in Wardsley or Village
on the west side of the street leading south from the
bridge - Beginning eight rods north of the north east
corner of Maxea T. Chapman's house lot at the corner
of a lot owned by Dennis Parkhurst from him running
North six rods to a stake from them mostly having clay and
two kinds rocks & a stately pine tree standing up in the
hill with the said stone & a stake from them mostly clay and
sometimes sand and contains one acre of land and
more and less, and is bounded east on the right bank and west
on the Grandy and south on Dennis Parkhurst's
AND also hereby remise, release and forever **quitclaim** all our right, title, and
interest to the premises aforesaid, to him the said *Orson Chapman*
we **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same to the said *Orson Chapman*
his heirs and assigns, to *him* and his
behalf forever.
AND *we* do covenant with the said *Orson Chapman* his
heirs and assigns, that *we* *are* lawfully seized in fee of the premises, that
we *have* good right to sell and convey the same to the said
*Orson Chapman**
