of the sum of five hundred dollars to us in hand paid by
Mary Stalley of the same town County & State aforesaid
the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge have owned
col & Ireland & former quit claims & also by these presents annu-
& former quit claims in to the said Mary Stalley her heirs
& assigns forever a certain lot of land lying in norwiche
bounded as follows to wit north by the highway near South
on land of Anthony At Sea South by the Mary Stalley
west by the County & Grantham South by the Road & also
bounded on the North lot number two the above lot being
number one on the Plat aforesaid being had to the
Plat of Division of the Colate of Mr Leavelly
lots of norwiche aforesaid,
So have and to hold the same together with all the
privileges & appurtenances therein to belonging to her
the said Mary Stalley her heirs & assigns forever
